**RBI in News:**

**Fifth Bi-monthly Monetary Policy Statement, 2017-18: Resolution of the Monetary Policy Committee (MPC)**

On the basis of an assessment of the current and evolving macroeconomic situation, the **Monetary Policy Committee** (MPC) decided to:

The projection of real GVA growth for 2017-18 of the October resolution at **6.7per cent** has been retained, with risks evenly balanced. On the whole, inflation is estimated in the range **4.3-4.7** per cent in Q3 and Q4 of this year, including the HRA effect of up to 35 basis points, with risks evenly balanced.

- The **Reserve Bank of India** opened a branch in the Dehradun to **make transactions** of the state government more convenient inaugurated by **CM Trivendra Singh Rawat**.
- **Reserve Bank of India (RBI)** has formed a **High-level Task Force** on **Public Credit Registry (PCR)** for India. The task force has been constituted under the chairmanship of **Yeshwant M. Deosthalee**.
- The **Reserve Bank of India** issued final guidelines for **prepaid payment instruments (PPI)** such as **closed, semi-closed and open wallets**. According to the new guidelines, all the PPIs will now be interoperable, which means will allow transaction with each other.
- The RBI has said banks will provide funds to women self-help groups, SHGs, in rural areas at **7 per cent** under the **Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana** – National Rural Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NRLM) in the current fiscal.
- The **Reserve Bank of India** has reportedly rejected **HDFC Bank’s** plea to declassify its parent **Housing Development Finance Corporation Limited (HDFC)** as a **foreign institutional investor (FII)**.

- State-owned Union Bank of India (UBI) plans to raise up to Rs 500 crore to comply with the global **standard Basel III banking norms by March 2019**.
- The global mobile payment solutions company '**OBOPAY**' has secured a license for **Prepaid Payment Instrument (PPI)** from the Reserve Bank of India to operate a semi-closed loop wallet in the country.
- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has imposed **Rs 3 crore** penalties on **IndusInd Bank** for breaching rules on income classification norms.
- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has imposed a penalty of **Rs 5 crore** on **Syndicate Bank**. It has been paid for their non-compliance with directions on "Cheque Purchase or Discounting, Bill Discounting, and Know Your Customer (KYC)" norms.
- **Bank of India (BOI)** became the eighth lender to come under the Reserve Bank of India's (RBI) **Prompt Corrective Action (PCA)**, as bad loans raised high and return on assets turned negative.
- **Bad loans** of Public sector banks (**PSBs**) stood at **Rs 7.34 lakh crore** by the end of second quarter this fiscal, a bulk of which came from corporate defaulters, private sector banks' NPAs were considerably low, according to data furnished by the **RBI**. Among the major government-owned banks, **State Bank of India** had the highest level of NPAs (Rs 1.86 lakh crore), followed by **Punjab National Bank** (Rs 57,630 crore), **Bank of India** (Rs 49,307 crore).

- **State Bank of India** has pared the **interest rate** on **retail term-deposits** of **one-year** maturity by **25 basis points**, to **50** per cent. The change is effective **October 1**.
- The **Odisha government's** Directorate of Treasuries and Inspection and the **State Bank of India** have signed an MOU for integration of **SBI e-Pay** with **cyber treasury**.
- The SBI Foundation has committed Rs10 crore for the conservation and restoration of the Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Terminus (CST) of Mumbai over a period of three to five years.
- **State Bank of India (SBI)** launched the **second edition** of its **Hackathon**. This hackathon has been named '**Digitize For Bank**'.
- The **State Bank of (SBI)**, the country's **largest public-sector lender**, said it has signed an agreement with Escorts Ltd to finance farmers **for purchase of Escorts tractors**.
- The **State Bank of India (SBI)** has decided to **slash Immediate Payment Service (IMPS)** charges by up to **80 percent**.

- **State Bank of India (SBI)** has cut its benchmark lending rate by **0.05** per cent across **maturities**, effective from November 1, according to an announcement by the state-run lender and also the MCLR has been changed to 7.70.
- **India's largest lender State Bank of India (SBI)** announced **reduction** of interest rates on home and automobile loans by **five basis points** (bps).
- **State Bank of India** has launched a unified integrated app called **YONO**. It offers all kinds of financial and lifestyle products. The abbreviation of YONO is **You Need Only One**. It is the **first digital banking platform** which offers customised products to the customer.
- The country's largest bank, State Bank of India, launched **State Bank Rewardz Scheme**. It is an enterprise-wise loyalty programme through which customers can earn reward points for various types of banking transactions.
- **SBI Card** and **Bharat Petroleum** have announced the launch of the **BPCL SBI Card** and claimed to be the '**most rewarding fuel co-branded credit card in the country**'.
- The country's largest lender SBI gets board approval for raising **Rs.8,000 crore through various sources**, including masala bonds, to meet Basel III capital norms. State Bank of India (SBI) said it had time **till March 2018 to raise the funds**.

- The **U.S. Federal Reserve** fined **HSBC Holdings PLC (HSBA.L)** **\$175 million** or "unsafe and unsound practices" in its foreign exchange trading business, the latest in a series of fines for banks that fail to prevent market manipulation.
- **Digital payments** firm **MobiKwik** announced its partnership with **IRCTC Rail connect app**, which will allow customers book railway tickets using the former's payment gateway.
- **India's renewable energy capacity** will **more than double** by **2022** to overtake renewable expansion in the **European Union** for the first time, **International Energy Agency (IEA)**.
- Fair trade regulator **CCI** imposed **finances** totalling **₹27 crore** on **Aditya Birla group firm Grasim Industries** and two others for **bid rigging Delhi Jal Board tenders** for supply of a **water purification product**.
- **PAN card** and **Aadhaar card** are not needed for **jewellery** purchases above **Rs 50,000**. The government decided to revoke the notification that extended provisions of the **Prevention of Money Laundering Act, 2002, (PMLA)** to **jewellery**.
- **HDFC Life Insurance Company** has launched '**Neo**', a servicing bot for Twitter that uses **artificial intelligence** for **customer service**. This is the second bot put in operation by HDFC Life, after the launch of SPOK, which was an email bot to answer customer queries.

- **Private insurer Tata AIA Life** announced the launch of '**Eazy Connect**' that will extend **online customer service** to **social media platforms**.
- **Vijaya Bank** has entered into a **MoU** with **Hindustan Petroleum Corporation Ltd (HPCL)** for enabling all HPCL retail outlets with BHIM/UPI merchant solutions.
- India's third largest private sector bank – **Axis Bank** acquired payments wallet Free charge for **Rs 373 crore** in an all-cash deal.
- **Reliance Capital arm** will get a **loan assistance** of **Rs.300 crore** from **IREDA** and utilise the funds for lending it to its renewable energy projects.
- Prime Minister **Narendra Modi** has approved **Rs.2,000 crore** specifically for setting up **Aadhaar centres** in post offices, a move that will see private contractors phased out from the data collection process.
- **Pension regulator PFRDA** notified the increase in maximum entry age limit for **National Pension System (NPS)** to **65 years**, its Chairman Hemant Contractor has said.
- The government has made biometric identification Aadhaar mandatory for all post office deposits, **PPF**, the **National Savings Certificate scheme** and **Kisan Vikas Patra**.
- The **National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD)** has sanctioned an amount **Rs. 273.06** crore to the Andhra Pradesh Government under **Rural Infrastructure Development Fund (RIDF)** for Rural Water supply, Road and Bridge projects.
- The **Andhra Pradesh** Government signed a **Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)** with **Master card** to setup a **centre of excellence** in **Visakhapatnam**.
- **Microsoft** has signed a **15-year** wind energy agreement with GE in **Ireland**, becoming one of the **first global technology firms** to support a new wind project in the country. It will purchase energy from **37-megawatt Tullahennel wind farm** in County Kerry, Ireland.
- **SEBI** has **tightened** the noose on listed companies not adhering to norms regarding **minimum public shareholding (MPS)**. Those that are **non-compliant** will have to pay a fine of **5,000 a day**.
- Regulator **SEBI** banned **Swasata Steel Industries Ltd (SSIL)** and its **seven directors** from the securities market for at least **four years** in a case related to illegally raising **Rs 12 crore** from the **public**.
- **HDFC Standard Life Insurance Company** has received capital markets regulator **Securities and Exchange Board of India's (SEBI)** go ahead to raise an estimated **Rs 7,500 crore** through an **Initial Public Offering (IPO)**.
- According to SEBI order, **Rupani's** alleged **manipulative transactions** took place between January-June 2011. His Hindu Undivided Family (HUF) has been asked to pay a fine of **Rs 15 lakh**.

- Country's largest private sector lender **ICICI Bank** committed a financial assistance of **Rs 10 crore** to the **Indian Armed Forces**.

- Agri service solutions provider **Sohan Lal Commodity Management (SLCM)** and **Myanmar** ties up with **HDFC Bank** and **IndusInd Bank** to provide **collateral management services**. SLCM will also leverage its proprietary (patent pending) technology '**Agri Reach**'.

- India signed a loan agreement worth **\$40 million** with the **World Bank** for **UP Pro-Poor Tourism Development Project**. It is aimed at increasing tourism-related benefits for local communities in Uttar Pradesh.

'**International AYUSH Conference and Exhibition 2017**' with the theme of '**Lifestyle diseases: Prevention and management through AYUSH**'.
- **Syria** has officially signed up to the **Paris Agreement**, the UN, leaving the United States as the only country to reject the global climate-rescue pact.
- An **Inter-Governmental Mid-Point review meeting of Asia and Pacific Decade** for Persons with Disabilities, 2013-2022 held in **Beijing, China**. Indian Union Minister of Social Justice & Empowerment **Thawar chand Gehlot** attended the meet.
- **India** has been re-elected to the **Council of the International Maritime Organisation**.
- **Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species (CITES)** of Wild Fauna and Flora was held in Geneva, Switzerland.
- The first phase of the **Chabahar port project** is known as the Shahid Beheshti port and it is inaugurated by Iranian President **Hassan Rouhani**.
- **Venezuela** launched its own **crypto currency called Petro** to circumvent US-led financial sanctions.
- **Australia** has officially become the **26th country** legalise **same-sex marriage** after the Parliament passes historic law.
- **India** on held the **fourth edition of the trilateral meet** with Japan and Australia in **New Delhi**. To maintain the momentum of partnership between like-minded countries to ensure an "open and free" Indo-Pacific stance.
- The World Health Organisation has declared **Gabon** a "**polio-free country**".
- **India** will be the guest of honour during **the sixth edition of the World Government Summit** scheduled from February 11th – 13th, 2018 in **Dubai**.

- **Japan** will simplify its **visa rules** from **January 1, 2018** for Indians and issue multiple-entry-visa for short-term stay, a move which is expected to benefit tourists and business persons as well as repeat visitors, the Japanese embassy.
- **Canada** will be the **partner country at the 23rd iteration of the Tech Summit**, India's largest knowledge and technology conference and exhibition to be held in New Delhi. The Summit is organized by the Confederation of Indian Industry (CII) and the Indian Department of Science and Technology (DST).
- **Russian Defence Ministry** said the armed forces have launched **four ballistic missiles** as part of large-scale war games involving Russia's strategic forces. ### CHINA:

- **China** announced commissioning its **first radar-evading Chengdu J-20 stealth fighter jets** into military service at the 11th Air show China in Zhuhai, Guangdong Province.
- The **world's first hybrid electric tram** powered by **hydrogen fuel** cells has started running in **China**, marking a big step in the application of green energy in public transport.
- **China** unveiled **Asia's largest artificial island-building ship**. The 140-metre-long vessel, which has been dubbed as "magic island maker", is capable of digging 6,000 cubic metres an hour.

- **China** launched the **world's first all-electric ship**, which can travel up to 80 km with 2000-tonnes cargo after a two-hour charge. It was launched in **Guangzhou in South China's** Guangdong Province. The ship has been manufactured by the Guangzhou Shipyard International Company Limited.
- China launched **three remote sensing satellites (Jilin-1 04, Jilin 1 05 and Jilin-1 06)** from **Xichang Satellite Launch Centre in South Western Sichuan Province** and it was designed to improve observation capability to promote commercial use for the remote sensing industry.
- The **3rd edition of the Dialogue** between the NITI Aayog and the Development Research Council of China, the DRC- NITI Aayog Dialogue was held **in Beijing**. The meeting was co-chaired by Vice Chairman NITI Aayog, Dr. Rajiv Kumar, and Mr Li Wei, President (Minister), DRC.
- **China's** domestically developed "**AG600**", the **World's Largest Amphibious Aircraft**, performed its maiden flight. It took off from the Jinwan Civil Aviation Airport at Zhuhai in Guangdong Province.
- **The World's Longest Glass Bridge** has been opened in **China**. It is located in **Shijiazhuang, Hebei province near Beijing**, the capital of China. The bridge stretches **488 meters** long and **two meters** wide.
- **The first photovoltaic (solar) highway** based on home-grown technology was successfully tested in **Shandong province of China**. The road has wireless charging systems for electric vehicles. China became the **second country** in the world to construct a photovoltaic highway **after France**.
- China has launched the **World's Largest Human Genome Research Project** to document the **genetic makeup of one lakh people to help generate the precision medicines for the future**.

### USA:

- The **11th Trade Policy Forum (TPF) Meeting** was held in **Washington D.C**. The Minister for Commerce and Industry, **Shri Suresh Prabhu** had productive discussions with the United States Trade Representative, Ambassador Robert Lighthizer.
- **NASA** has launched the satellite for the **National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration**, so that it will improve the accuracy of weather forecasts. The **Joint Polar Satellite System-1 (JPSS-1)** lifted off on a United Launch Alliance Delta II rocket **from Vandenberg Air Force Base, California**.
- Planet Labs Inc, a US-based integrated aerospace and data analytics company, announced four of its Dove satellites will be launched **aboard India's PSLV-C40 mission, scheduled to fly in January 2018**.
- **US** withdraws from UN Global Compact on Migration.

### BANGLADESH:

- The deal between **Bangladesh Petroleum Corporation (BPC)** and **Numaligarh Refinery Limited (NRL)** was signed in presence of India's external affairs minister Sushma Swaraj, who arrived in Dhaka recently on a two-day visit to discuss bilateral issues.
- **Adani Power** said its arm **Adani Power (Jharkhand)** has inked **long-term pact** with **Bangladesh Power Development Board** to supply electricity from its upcoming 1,600 MW plant at Godda in Jharkhand.

- ❖ Visually impaired swimmer **Kanchanmala Pande** scripted history becoming the **first Indian to win gold** at the **World Para Swimming Championship** in Mexico.
- ❖ Australia beat Argentina in the final of the Hockey World League Final (HWLF) to **win gold at Kalinga Stadium, Bhubaneswar**. **India beat Germany to win bronze medal** in Hockey world League.
- ❖ **India bagged 21 medals** at the 10th Asian Championship 10m Rifle/Pistol **at Wako City Japan and also booked 4 Youth Olympic Games quotas**.
- ❖ **Shubhankar Sharma** wins in **Joburg Golf Open**.
- ❖ India become the first-ever team to register **300+ totals 100 times in ODIs**, after posting 392/4 against **Sri Lanka in Mohali**.
- ❖ India's men and women's hockey teams remained in the 6th and 10th positions respectively in the rankings revealed by the **International Hockey Federation (FIH)**.
- ❖ The **Board of Control for Cricket** in India (BCCI), announced that **India** will be hosting the ICC Cricket World Cup on 2023 and the ICC Champions Trophy in 2021.
- ❖ World Youth Champion **Sachin Siwach** was named the Asian Boxing Confederation's **Best Youth Boxer of the Year**.

- ❖ India's top-ranked junior shuttler Aakarshi Kashyap won U-17 and U-19 singles titles at **42nd Badminton junior Nationals in Guwahati, Assam.**
- ❖ Lionel Messi, has received **La Liga's top scorer and best player awards for the 2016-2017 football season.**
- ❖ **India captain Mithali Raj** was named in the **ICC Women's ODI Team of the Year** while left-arm spinner **Ekta Bisht** was the lone cricketer to find a place in the both **the ODI and T20 Teams** of the year announced by the world body. **Harmanpreet Kaur** has found out a place in the **ICC Women's T20 Team of the Year.**
- ❖ **Vijender Singh** defended his **WBO Oriental and Asia Pacific super middleweight titles** against Ghana's Ernest Amuzu at the Sawai Mansingh Stadium in Jaipur.
- ❖ **IOC bans 11 Russians** for life over alleged Sochi Games doping violations.
- ❖ Indian boxers have claimed three gold, a silver, and a bronze medal at the Galym Zharylgapov Boxing Tournament. The event was held in **Karaganda, Kazakhstan.** The Gold Medal winners were **K Shyam Kumar** in 49kg, **Naman Tanwar** in 91kg and **Satish Kumar** in the +91kg category claimed gold medals.
- ❖ **India** finished as runners-up in the **SAFF Under-15 Women's Championships.** India lost to Bangladesh 0-1 in the final at **Dhaka.**
- ❖ In Cricket, Team **India** has risen to the **second spot** in the latest ICC Twenty-20 rankings. **Pakistan** is at the top of the list. In the rankings for batsmen, Indian captain **Virat Kohli** slipped to **third.** The list is led by Aussie opener **Aaron Finch**, followed by West Indian **Evin Lewis.** Among the bowlers, **Jasprit Bumrah** has been pushed to the **third spot** behind Pakistan's Imad Wasim and Afghanistan's Rashid Khan.
- ❖ **Saudi Arabia** is hosting the **World Chess Tournament** for the **first time.** Two years ago, the country's top cleric issued a religious order against playing the board game. The tournament has been named as the **King Salman World Rapid and Blitz Chess Championships.**
- ❖ Haryana shooter **Anisa Sayyed** won the **women's 25m pistol gold** with a **new record at 61st National Shooting Championship Competitions (61st NSCC), in Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala.** She beat Shital Shivaji Thorat and Rahi Sarnobat who won silver and bronze respectively.
- ❖ The Indian men's football ended the year at **105th spot in the FIFA rankings.** India began the year at 129th spot and in July, broke into top **100 by occupying 96th.** **Iran (32)** are the highest ranked Asian team and are followed by **Australia and Japan.** Among Asian countries, the Indian team

is in the **15th spot**. World champions Germany ended on top to be **FIFA's 'Team of the Year'**, followed by Brazil, Portugal, Argentina.

- ❖ Delhi Sultans buy **Double Olympic medallist Sushil Kumar for Rs 55 lakh**, the highest bid in the history of the tournament during the **Pro Wrestling League auctions** in New Delhi. Sushil is now the most expensive player in the history of the tournament.
- ❖ Indian chess ace Viswanathan Anand has won the **World Rapid Chess Championship in Riyadh**, Saudi Arabia. In the final, Anand beat Russia's Vladimir Fedoseev to reclaim the title.
- ❖ Real Madrid star **Cristiano Ronaldo** has been named **Globe Soccer's Best Player for the second year** in a row and the fourth time overall. He also won his **fifth Ballon d'Or, the UEFA Best Player in Europe and FIFA's The Best Award** this year (2017).
- ❖ In Shooting, ace Indian marksman **Jitu Rai won the Men's 50-metre pistol national title at the 61st National Shooting Championships in Thiruvananthapuram**. Jitu's army teammate Jai Singh secured bronze with an effort of 198.4. **Arjun Singh Cheema** of Punjab won the junior men's 50-metre pistol event.
- ❖ Olympic bronze medallist **Sakshi Malik** was named in the Indian women's wrestling team for **2018 Commonwealth Games** in Gold Coast, Australia. Apart from Sakshi, who is in the 62kg category, other women grapplers who booked their berths for the 2018 Commonwealth Games are: **Vinesh Phogat (50kg), Babita Kumari (54kg), Pooja Dhanda (57kg), Divya Karan (68 kg) and Kiran (76kg)**.
- ❖ Indian chess Grand master and five-time World Champion **Viswanathan Anand** bagged a bronze in the **World Blitz Chess Championship at Riyadh**, Saudi Arabia. World Champion **Magnus Carlsen** won the tournament and followed by Sergey Karjakin.
