<u>Curriculum</u>

I Orientation Courses and Refresher Courses:

The Orientation Programmes are designed as per the UGC guidelines and the syllabi prescribed for Orientation Programmes. The Orientation Programme which is a multi-disciplinary course with a 4-week duration with 5 components prescribed by the UGC (revised) including component 'B' with 4 components are retained with slight changes in their contents.

In addition to this, Academic Staff College, Mysore has added several other components to both Orientation Programmes and Refresher Courses. The information on Yoga, Meditation, Stress Management, Soft Skill Development, Women Empowerment, Folklore, Spiritual Values, writing / preparing project proposals, Cultural activities, visit to Laboratory, Museums, historical and heritage places is an added knowledge to the participants.

II Other Programmes organized :

Apart from Orientation Programmes and Refresher Courses Academic Staff College, Mysore is conducting special programmes for Teaching staff, Non-teaching staff, Drawing and Disbursing Officers, Principals, Research Scholars, Project Investigators of Research Projects, etc. The innovative programmes such as Principals Workshop, Workshop on Stress Management, Soft skills development, Leadership development skills, Motivation and Attitude Change etc. are being conducted. Short term Refresher course for teaching and non-teaching staff of University of Mysore including Affiliated Colleges, Orientation Programme for Research Scholars.
