

About Indian Institute of Technology Delhi (IITD)

The Indian Institutes of Technology (popularly known as IITs) are institutions of national importance established through Act of Parliament for fostering excellence in education. There are fifteen IITs at present, located in Bhubaneswar, Chennai, Delhi, Gandhinagar, Guwahati, Hyderabad, Indore, Jodhpur, Kanpur, Kharagpur, Mandi, Mumbai, Patna, Ropar and Roorkee. Over the years, IITs have created world class educational platforms dynamically sustained through internationally recognized research based on excellent infrastructural facilities. The faculty and alumni of IITs continue to make significant impact in all sectors of society, both in India and abroad.

The Indian Institute of Technology Delhi established in 1961 is one of the premier institute for technology and science. However, after realising the importance of management education, M.Tech. (Management Systems) was started in 1976. Indian Institute of Technology Delhi is situated in Hauz Khas (South Delhi) and has a sprawling campus in an area of 320 acres. Imaginatively laid out with picturesque landscape, the campus has Academic Blocks, Residential Areas, Shopping Areas and Playing Grounds with well-connected and neatly laid out roads. Recently, IIT Delhi completed 50 years of its existence and the golden jubilee celebrations were held with lot of enthusiasm.

The Institute has 13 Departments, 11 multi-disciplinary Centres and 2 Schools of Excellence conducting various programs including undergraduate (B.Tech., Dual Degree program and Integrated M.Tech.), Post graduate (M.Tech., M.Sc., MS(Research), MBA, M.Des.) and doctorate (Ph.D.) programs. Eminent faculty, excellent academic infrastructure and Superior Pedagogy make the institute one of the best places in the country to learn and research.

The institute organises various conferences, conclaves and fests which celebrate technology, innovation and management. About Department of Management Studies (DMS)

Post Graduate Management education began in IIT Delhi in 1976 with Prof. Sudhir Kakar as first Co-ordinator of the PG program in what was then the 'School of System and Management Studies'. Through gradual process of evolution, when Prof. Vinayshil Gautam was the Head in 1993, it acquired the statutory status of 'Department of Management Studies' under I.I.T. Delhi Act. The formal appellation of Master of Business Administration (MBA) for PG program in management came in 1997.

The Department currently runs a three MBA programs: two-year full-time MBA programmes with focus on 'Management Systems', a two-vear full-time MBA programme with focus on 'Telecommunication Systems Management' under the aegis of Bharti School of Telecom Technology and Management and a three-year part-time MBA programme with focus on 'Technology Management'. Apart from the specialised compulsory courses in the focus area, the students have choice for functional area

specialization in Finance, Marketing, Information Systems, Strategy, Organisation Management, HR etc. The students in two-year full time MBA programme are admitted through a rigorous screening process including CAT(Common Admissions Test)*, Group discussion and Personal interview. This test is used by all the IITs & IISc for admissions to their management programme. Admission to MBA (Part-Time) programme is also done through a process of written test, group discussion and interview, organized in a customised mode.

* Until 2011, JMET (Joint Management Entrance Test) was conducted by IITs for admissions to their two year full-time Management Programs

Infrastructure and Facilities

The Department of Management Studies has 5 fully airconditioned Wi-Fi enabled lecture theatres equipped with LCD projectors to ensure the best possible environment for learning. The auditorium has a seating capacity of over 150 and hosts numerous guest lectures, seminars and other programmes. In addition to a large collection of management books, the departmental library houses one of the biggest collections of managementrelated fieldwork reports available in any institution. Further, the Behavioural Laboratory has in-house camera, TV, VCR and specialised software to help the students hone their behavioural skills.

Student Life

Student life at DMS provides variety and excitement unmatched by any other business school in the country. The departmental clubs and committees provide enriching platforms for learning and leadership. The department's sports teams can draw upon the excellent facilities provided at IIT Delhi and compete regularly at national level sports meets. The 12 hostels where the students reside are completely self-contained with each hostel including a mess, common room, gymnasium, reading room, facilities for indoor games etc. The hostels are run by an elected Hostel Secretary, who is supported by Cultural, Mess and Maintenance Secretaries. There are also hostel representatives for each of the 9 clubs under the Board for Recreational and Cultural Activities (BRCA) and sports captains for each sport. The high amount of student involvement in running the hostels plays a key role in grooming them as future leaders in their respective walks of life.

The inter-hostel championships for each club and the overall BRCA Trophy are hotly contested. From debating



to darts and photography to, no week passes without a plethora of events. The sports trophies are legendary in their intensity. No quarter is given or asked for as students compete in sports ranging from weightlifting to waterpolo. A campus with playgrounds for football, cricket and hockey; multiple courts for tennis, badminton, basketball and volleyball and an Olympic size swimming pool forms the perfect backdrop to these battles.

Any description of student life at the institute would be incomplete without a description of the fests. Rendezvous, North India's largest cultural fest brings together the best college talent of the country to compete in almost a hundred events. Performers such as Euphoria and KK have battled at Rendezvous' music competitions long before they were household names. Famous national and international artists perform at Rendezvous every year. Tryst – the technical festival also occupies pride of place in the calendar of Indian technical fests, Smaller fests organized by various IIT Delhi student bodies include the literary fest Literati and Speranza – the fest of the Board for Student Welfare. Not to be left behind, DMS organizes Parivartan - a business fest which sees enthusiastic participation from top tier business schools across the nation.

Amidst such a plethora of opportunities, the DMS student has only one grouse – there is only so much that can be packed into the 24 hours of a day!
