

Short Term Research Scholarships in Germany (1 to 10 months)

Type of Scholarship:

- For doctoral candidates or young Post-Docs wishing to carry out a particular part of their advanced current research (for which the local conditions are unfavourable) in Germany
- Beginning of programme: depending on the arrangement with the host institution, but not before February following the year of application

Requirements:

- Registered Ph.D. candidates or recent post-docs (Master's degree must have been completed less than 6 years ago at time of application)
- Resident, employed and granted leave of absence from the employing institution
- Detailed outline of the intended research project
- Letter from a German university/institution agreeing to receive and advise the candidate
- Proficiency in English

Application:

- Deadline is 15 October of the year preceding the commencement of the Scholarship
- Application Forms available at the DAAD Office (MUK, International Office) or on e-mail request (daad.uganda@yahoo.de)

Scholarships for Postgraduate Courses for Professionals with Relevance to Developing Countries

Type of Scholarship:

- Postgraduate studies of particular subjects
- Degrees: Master, Doctorate, Certificate
- Language of instruction: mostly English

Requirements:

- Bachelor's degree (must have been completed less than 6 years ago at time of application) in a relevant subject, with a CGPA of at least 3.60
- Following the first degree, at least two years professional experience outside the university in a relevant field (exception: Ph.D. courses)

Application:

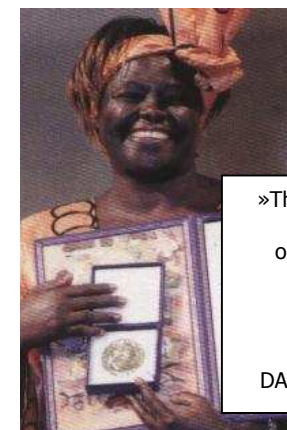
- Candidates must apply for admission (to the university) and scholarship (preferably to the university or to the DAAD head office in Bonn/Germany) simultaneously
- Please observe the deadlines set by the university and DAAD respectively

In-Country/In-Region Scholarships

Type of Scholarship:

- In-Country scholarships are only available for courses at Makerere University Kampala and Mbarara University of Science and Technology
- For In-Region scholarships and admission to courses, candidates must inquire from and apply to one of the designated networks
- Initially awarded for one year only; annual (or shorter) extension is possible
- Maximum period for Master's degree is 2 years, for Ph.D. 3 years
- DAAD will pay tuition fees to the university and a monthly stipend to the scholarship holder as well as an annual study and research allowance

Requirements:

- Present or prospective staff member of a public university or from the public sector aiming at a Master's degree or a Ph.D. in a discipline having strong relevance to national development (not older than 36 years)
- Applications from female candidates are especially encouraged
- Bachelor's and/or Master's degree qualification with a CGPA of at least 3.60
- Proof of admission to the desired degree course
- Recommendation by Head of Department
- Declaration of acceptance from an academic supervisor (for Ph.D. candidates only)

Application:

- Deadline is 14 May of year of scholarship commencement
- Application forms and further information are available at the DAAD Office (MUK, International Office)

»Sandwich« Scholarships

Type of Scholarship:

- Combining periods of study/research in Germany with those in Uganda leading to a Ph.D. in Uganda
- Duration initially for 1 year (preceded by a 4-months language course in Germany if appropriate)
- Extension may be granted, provided progress is good
- Scholarship covers only the period of study/research in Germany up to a maximum of 2 years
- Scholarships in the field of medicine are limited to 1 year and do not lead to a doctorate or a specialization degree in Germany

Requirements:

- Junior lecturer or graduate/teaching/research assistant
- A CGPA of at least 3.60 in Bachelor's and Master's (must have been completed less than 6 years ago at time of application) degree
- Resident, employed and granted leave of absence from the employing institution
- Registered Ph.D. candidate at the home university
- Established contacts between the home and the host institution
- Secured academic supervisors in the home country and Germany (written mutual agreement)
- Detailed outline of the study/research project to be undertaken in Germany

Application:

- Deadline is 15 October of the year preceding the commencement of the Scholarship
- Application forms and further information are available at the DAAD Office (MUK, International Office) or on e-mail request (daad.uganda@yahoo.de)

One-Year Scholarships for Postgraduate Studies in Germany

Type of Scholarship:

- Duration initially for 1 year (preceded by a 6-months language course in Germany if appropriate)
- Extension may be granted, provided progress is good (for a Ph.D. three years, in exceptional cases four years)
- Beginning of programme: by April the earliest, usually by October following the year of application, and beginning with a language course in Germany
- Scholarships in the field of medicine are limited to 1 year and do not lead to a doctorate or a specialization degree in Germany

Requirements:

- Junior lecturer or graduate/teaching/research assistant aiming either at a German doctoral degree or at a doctorate from his/her home university
- Resident, employed and granted leave of absence from the employing institution
- A CGPA of at least 3.60 in Bachelor's and Master's (must have been completed less than 6 years ago at time of application) degree; applicants in the medical field must have started their specialisation training
- Recent letter of acceptance from a professor at a German university (supervisor)
- Detailed outline of the study/research project to be undertaken in Germany

- Deadline is 15 October of the year preceding the commencement of the Scholarship
