

**ADVERTISEMENT FOR RECRUITMENT OF CONSTABLE (TRADESMEN) (MALE) IN  
BORDER SECURITY FORCE**

Applications are invited from **MALE** Indian citizens for the post of Constable (Tradesmen), Group 'C' **Combatised, Non- Gazetted ( Non- Ministerial)**, in the **Pay Band -I Rs. 5200-20200 + Grade pay Rs. 2000/-** plus usual and admissible allowances to Central Govt. Employees from time to time. The appointment is on temporary basis likely to be permanent. The posts have All India liability and selected candidates can be posted anywhere in India and even abroad. On appointment, the candidates shall be governed by the Border Security Force Act and Rules.

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**Note:-** Candidates require relaxation in any of the eligibility criteria must produce certificates issued by concerned authority at the time of recruitment so that they can take benefit accordingly.

5. **ELIGIBILITY FOR RE-EMPLOYMENT OF EX- SERVICEMEN-** Ex servicemen being trained soldiers only written test, trade test and medical fitness test to ascertain Medical category will be conducted. As per Govt's order total relaxation in prescribed physical standard and education is admissible. Relaxation of upper age limit to the extent of military service plus 3 years. No. Physical efficiency test will be held for Ex- Servicemen.

6. Persons serving in Govt/Semi Govt department may send their applications through proper channel along with 'No Objection Certificate' as per format in **Annexure-III**.

7. Wards (**Sons**) of serving BSF personal may also apply. Sons of serving BSF personnel may apply either from their Home State or from the State in which his father is posted/deployed at the time of recruitment.

8. **Method of Selection**

(a) **Height Bar Test** : At the very beginning of the recruitment process, Candidates whose applications are found to be in Order will be asked to go through the height bar and Thereby, candidates with lesser height will get eliminated.

(b) **Physical Efficiency Test (PET)** : Candidates who qualify the height test will be subjected to five kilometres race to be completed within 24 minutes.

(c) **Checking of Documents** : Testimonials of the will be checked. Original documents will be returned on the spot after verification and attested photocopies of certificates will be retained with the application.

**It is important that the candidates applying for this recruitment check their eligibility, to avoid disappointment at later stage.**

(d) **Physical Standard Test(PST)** : Candidates who are found eligible on screening of testimonials will be screened first for height, chest and weight measurements.

**Note:- Physical Efficiency Tests will only be qualifying in nature and it will not carry any marks.**

(e) **Trade test:** : **Only qualifying in nature.**  
The candidates who qualify the PET will be put Through the respective Trade Test.

**Each candidate will be allowed to appear for One trade only as entered in the application form.**

(f) **Written Test:** **For 100 marks.**

(i) The candidates who qualify in the PETs and Trade Test will be required to appear in a written test on a date and venue which will be endorsed by the PST/PET board in his admit card.

(ii) The Written Test for 100 marks containing 100 questions (qualifying marks 35% for GC & Ex-Servicemen and 33% for SC/ST/OBC) will consist of only OMR based objective type multiple choice questions to be answered using a black pen.

(iii) The question paper will be set to assess the (i) general awareness/ general knowledge, (ii) knowledge of elementary mathematics, (iii) analytical aptitude and ability to observe the distinguish patterns and to test the (iv) basic knowledge of the candidates in English/Hindi. The questions will be set both in Hindi and English. The papers can be answered **either in Hindi or in English**

(iv) The duration of the Written Test will be 2 hours.

(v) **It is intimated that the OMR answer sheet of written test will be processed/ scanned in electronic machine. Any wrong entry of roll number etc will render the OMR sheet invalid and the same will not be evaluated. The candidates concerned will be responsible for such mistakes on their part.**

9. **Merit List :** Merit list in each category, namely Gen, SC, ST, OBC and Ex- servicemen will be drawn on the basis of marks obtained by the candidates in the written test. On the basis of this merit. The candidates shall be short listed for detailed medical examination as per the trade wise and category- wise vacancies.

10. **Detailed Medical Examination:** Candidates shortlisted in order of merit as per trade wise and category wise number of vacancies. Will be called for detailed medical examination to assess their fitness.

11. **Appeal in case of rejection in detailed medical examination:-**

i) A candidate declared unfit in detailed medical examination if not satisfied with the findings of the Medical Officer, can submit an **application for his re- medical examination with a duly filled Medical certificate as per Annexure-V as a proof of evidence about the error of judgment of the part of Recruitment Medical Officer.**

ii) The medical certificate will not be taken into consideration unless it contains a note by the medical practitioner concerned to the effect that it has been given in full knowledge of the fact that the candidate has already been rejected as unfit for appointment in BSF by a Medical Officer.

iii) The appeal will also not be taken into consideration unless it contains Medical Re- Examination Fee of Rs. 50/- in form of Indian Postal Order or Demand Draft in favour of the concerned Recruiting Agency of BSF.

iv) The appeal complete in all respects should be submitted within 15 days from the date of issue of the communication i.e Rejection Slip in which the finding of the Medical Officer are communicated to the candidate. The application for re- medical examination shall be sent to the concerned recruiting Agency of BSF. Appeals received after the due date will not be entertained. **BSF will not be responsible for any late receipt of the appeals due to postal delay.**

v) **The decision of the re-medical board of BSF shall be final and no 2<sup>nd</sup> appeal will be entertained as per Govt. Instructions and also no reply of the correspondence/ 2<sup>nd</sup> appeal will be given/ entertained.**

12. **HOW TO APPLY AND BY WHICH DATE**

a) Application in the prescribed format given at **Annexure-I** may be downloaded and printed out on one side foolscap plain paper. The application form and admit card duly filled. Affixed passport size photographs attested by a Gazette officer with seal be submitted to the concerned recruiting agency of **BSF** under which their state falls. The applications should reach the concerned Recruiting Agency on **or before 30 days from the date of publication of this advertisement in Employment News** along with following documents.



- i) Postal order or Demand Draft for Rs. 50/- in favour of Concerned IG/DIG/Commandant payable at bank of concerned Headquarter, under which their state falls, as mentioned against each with Code No. However, no postal order or Demand Draft is required to be sent by SC/ST candidates and Ex- servicemen.
- ii) Candidates are requested to fill up application form in Hindi or English language.
- iii) Attested copies of certificate/testimonial as proof of Educational qualification and age/date of birth and a trade proficiency certificate.
- iv) Attested copy of caste/category certificate for SC/ST/OBC candidates given by an officer not below Tehsildar or SDO/SDM etc as per **Annexure-IV (1) /(2)**.
- v) Attested copy of Domicile certificate issued by an officer not below Tehsildar or SDO/SDM etc.
- vi) One self addressed envelope of size 23x10 Cms affixed with postage for Rs. 5/- bearing name and full postal address of the candidate with PIN Code.
- vii) A form for issue of Admit card will also be filled in and forwarded along with Passport size photographs duly attested by a Gazetted Officer with seal as per **Annexure-II** along with application form.
- viii) Envelope containing Application must be subscribed in bold letters as

**13. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS**

i) Admit card with roll number and general instructions for appearing for the test/interview will be issued 15 days prior to the date of test to the eligible candidates. They will be called to appear for the same at a place preferably within their Home State for which no TA/DA is admissible. ***List of candidates who have been called for appearing in the PST/PET and Trade Test would be uploaded in the BSF website 15 days prior to the date of commencement of PST/PET and Trade Test. Candidates who do not receive their admit cards can down load a copy of the notice along with the page wherein his name appears and report at the PST.PET venue along with 3 passport size photographs for issuance of duplicate admit card by PST/PET board.***

ii) The candidature will be accepted only provisionally. Candidates are advised to go through the requirements of educational qualification, age, physical standards, etc and satisfy themselves that they are eligible for the post. If any claim made in the application is not found substantiated the candidature will be cancelled and the BSF's decision in this regard shall be final.

iii) Candidates will appear in the PET ( i.e. 5 Km Race, Long Jump and High Jump) at their own risk. BSF will not be held responsible for any kind of mishappening. injuries that may cause to the candidates during the recruitment process.

iv) Simply appearing/qualifying in the recruitment tests does not provide right to the candidates for selection in BSF.
