

1. Applications can be submitted **ONLINE (ONLY)** from 11.09.2012 to 03.10.2012 with non-refundable fees of Rs. 400/- (Rs. 200/- in case of SC candidates). For the purpose of knowing the requisite qualifications/ general instructions/selection criteria/ other details etc and for filing online applications, the prospective candidates may log on to the website of the Society i.e. [www.ssachd.nic.in](http://www.ssachd.nic.in) or <http://recruitment.cdacmohali.in>.
2. List of all those candidates, who might apply on or before the closing date, will be displayed for 'confirmation of fee deposits' on 09.10.2012 for validation by the candidates. Thereafter, a Provisional Merit List will be displayed.
3. Category wise cut-off scores, based on double the number of vacancies in each category will be notified and candidates covered within these cut-offs, will report for verification of original documents (from 30.10.2012 to 01.11.2012 at Govt. Model Sr. Sec. School, Sector-10, Chandigarh). There could be more rounds of verification, if need be.
4. Candidate-wise schedule for checking of original documents can be seen on the above-mentioned websites 25.10.2012. No separate intimation will be sent in this regard.
5. **All the notices and updates will be uploaded on the above-mentioned web-sites. Thus, the candidates are advised to visit these sites on a regular basis.**

**QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE POST OF JBT TEACHERS (A & B):**

- A** (i) Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks from a recognized Board / University and 2-year Diploma in Elementary Education (by whatever name known).

**OR**

Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 45% marks in accordance with the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2002 and 2-year Diploma in Elementary Education (by whatever name known).

**OR**

Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks from a recognized Board / University and 2-year Diploma in Education (Special Education).

**OR**

Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks from a recognized Board / University and 4-year Bachelor of Elementary Education (B.El.Ed.)

**OR**

Graduation and 2-year Diploma in Elementary Education (by whatever name known).

- B** Pass in Teacher Eligibility Test (TET), conducted by the CBSE, New Delhi in accordance with the Guidelines framed by the NCTE.

**AGE:**

The age limit for the post of JBT is 21-35 years. Age is to be calculated in reference to the closing date for submission of applications.

**AGE RELAXATION & RESERVATION:**

Age is relaxable up to 45 years in the case of widows, deserted women and handicapped; up to 40 years for SC/ST; 40 years for Govt. servants and Women; and up to 38 years for OBCs. Ex-Servicemen or any other category will be given age

relaxation as per the rules of Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan Society, U.T., Chandigarh. The society follows rules/instructions of Chandigarh Administration in this regard. No candidate will be accorded age relaxation and benefit of reservation unless he/she attaches the requisite certificate issued by competent authority at the time of counselling/verification of documents. Under OBC category, candidates of those castes will be given benefit which is existing in the list notified by Chandigarh Administration and Central list of OBC meant for U.T., Chandigarh. List of OBC category is available on the website of Society. The candidates have to submit certificate regarding caste and declarations regarding "Creamy Layer" as per the Instructions of Govt of India/Chandigarh Administration.

**PROCEDURE FOR SUBMISSION OF ONLINE APPLICATIONS:**

1. Applications will be accepted online (only) from 11.09.2012 to 03.10.2012 on the website of Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan Society, Chandigarh i.e. [www.ssachd.nic.in](http://www.ssachd.nic.in) or [www.recruitment.cdacmohali.in](http://www.recruitment.cdacmohali.in). Fee can be deposited upto 04.10.2012.
2. Application fees (non-refundable) amounting to Rs. 400/- (Rs. 200/- in case of SC candidates) will be payable through challan, generated after online filing of application. Candidates belonging to SC category must ensure that they have valid caste certificate issued by the competent authority. In case, at the time of verification of documents, it is found that certificate is not valid, their candidature will be rejected. Such candidates will not be considered under

- the general category as they have not paid fees applicable for candidates of general category.
3. To submit the application, a candidate has to log on to the website of the society i.e. [www.ssachd.nic.in](http://www.ssachd.nic.in) or [www.recruitment.cdacmohali.in](http://www.recruitment.cdacmohali.in) and click on the link "Application for the post of "JBT".
  4. Any correction in the particulars can be made by the candidate himself/herself on the website up to 03.10.2012 upto 11:00 AM. For this purpose, the candidate has to log in by entering registration no. and password. No correction can be made by the candidate after the closing date.
  5. After submission of online applications, registration form will be generated. Candidate has to take out two printouts of the registration form and the same has to be brought on the date of document verification along with all the documents - both original and one self-attested photo copy of each thereof.
  6. Candidates are advised not to disclose their password to anybody.
  7. For any help for submission of online applications, candidates can contact at Phone No. 0172-6619054, 6619055 from 09:00 AM to 5:00 PM only on all working days.
  8. All the notices and updates will be uploaded on the websites mentioned above. Thus, the candidates are advised to visit the site on a regular basis. No separate intimation will generally be sent through post or other means. Any information that is uploaded on either of the two above-mentioned sites will be deemed to have reached the candidates and responsibility for not visiting the site and responding thereto in time, will be entirely of the candidates.
  9. Before applying for the post of JBT, candidates must ensure that he/she fulfils all the eligibility conditions mentioned in the advertisement. Eligibility will be checked with reference to closing date for submission of applications.
  10. Detailed instructions to fill-up online application are available on the website of the society i.e. [www.ssachd.nic.in](http://www.ssachd.nic.in) or [www.recruitment.cdacmohali.in](http://www.recruitment.cdacmohali.in) on the link "Application for the post of JBT".

**NOTE:**

- (i) Venue for verification of original documents will be Govt. Model Sr. Sec. School, Sec-10, Chandigarh. The candidates will report at the venue along with print out of application/registration form, original certificates for qualifications and proof of category, latest photograph and self-attested copies of documents. No weightage will be given for qualification/category, for which original certificates are not produced on the said date.
- (ii) No request for change of document verification schedule will be entertained.
- (iii) Selection will be made purely on the basis of merit and simply attending the document verification schedule does not vest any candidate with any right to appointment.
- (iv) Candidates, who are covered within the cut-off, based on double the number of vacancies advertised in each category, will report during the first round of process of verification of original documents. However, depending on requirement, there can be two or more rounds for verification of original documents.
- (v) Candidates figuring in any reserve category in the provisional merit list may be shifted to general category in the final merit list, if they are able to score more marks than the last candidate in the general category. This will be done strictly as per the rules/instructions relating to reservation for different categories

**GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:**

- (i) No print out of online application is required to be submitted. When a candidate fills up online application, his score will be calculated as per the pre-laid criteria and displayed immediately. Later on, if/when a candidate edits his/her particulars, relating to merit points, his/her score will be updated

automatically. C-DAC will prepare the merit as per selection criteria on the basis of information given by the candidates in the online applications.

- (ii) **"Fee confirmation lists"** of candidates with detailed particulars (for candidates, who submitted their application within the stipulated period and deposited fee/ did not deposit fee (as per our records) within scheduled date, will be displayed on 09.10.2012. This list will also indicate the particulars entered by the candidates and scores/ weightages assigned as per the pre-laid selection criteria. This list will be prepared and displayed without checking of documents relating to eligibility as well as the qualifications.

Candidates will be given a chance for submission of proof of depositing the fee within the stipulated time (in case of those candidates, whose names are shown in the list of those, who did not pay the fee in the stipulated period as displayed on 09.10.2012.

- (iii) **"Provisional Merit List of all candidates"**, who submitted application and fee within the stipulated period for submission of objections/ grievances (This list will also include the detailed particulars and scores of the candidates as per the prescribed selection criteria).

**Checking of original documents will be done as per the schedule mentioned on the websites of SSA and C-DAC.** In the first round of process of verification of original documents, candidates, who are covered within the cut-off, based on double the number of vacancies advertised in each category, will repeat. (There could be more number of such rounds, depending upon the requirement of the Society.)

- (iv) Category wise cut-off score for verification of original documents will be notified and in the first round of process of verification of original documents, double the number of candidates of the vacancies advertised in each category will be called. However, the number of candidates can change in provisional /final merit list due to shifting of candidates from reserve to General category or vice versa , ineligibility, absenteeism or due to any other reason. Depending on requirement, there can be two/three rounds for verification of original documents.
- (v) Pass in Teacher Eligibility Test (TET) conducted by the CBSE New Delhi in accordance with the Guidelines framed by NCTE as applicable for class I to V is essential.
- (vi) Candidates with D.Ed (Special Education) qualification, if appointed, will undergo NCTE recognized six months special programme in elementary education after appointment. Candidates will undergo training at their own expense and no salary for the leave period will be paid. D.Ed (Special Education), a course recognised by the Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI) only shall be considered.

- (vii) Candidates, who had passed the Senior Secondary Examination before coming into operation of NCTE guidelines regarding the requirement of obtaining minimum of 50% marks in the Senior Secondary Examination, will be considered eligible, provided they have obtained a minimum of 45% marks in the said examination.
- (viii) Candidates eligible on the basis of graduation qualification and having less than 45% marks at Senior Secondary stage will not be given any weightage of higher qualification for graduate degree.
- (ix) In case, a candidate has passed any additional subject/paper, he/she can add the marks of additional paper, if the same are beneficial to him/her. However, the marks of additional paper will be substituted with other paper, only if, a candidate produces scheme of study, pass criteria and relevant instructions of University/Board to prove that passing of paper to be substituted was not compulsory.
- (x) In case, a candidate has passed any additional subject/paper, he/she can add the marks of additional paper. If marks sheet does not indicate that candidate has passed additional paper and the total is also not given in the marks sheet, marks of that paper will also be added unless and until candidate produces scheme of study, pass criteria and relevant instructions of University/Board to prove that passing of paper was not compulsory.
- (xi) At the time of calculation of marks at B. Ed level, marks obtained by the candidate in internal, external, theory, practical and any other marks given in the marks sheet are to be added to maintain the uniformity.
- (xii) At the time of calculation of marks at Diploma in elementary Education level, marks of 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> year and all the marks of theory, practical, internal, external etc. mentioned in the final mark sheet will be added to maintain the uniformity.
- (xiii) In case two or more candidates are having same score as per selection criteria, then a candidate having higher score in TET will rank higher in order or merit. Further, in case two or more candidates are having same score and same score in TET then a candidate having higher score in Professional Qualification will rank higher in order or merit.
- (xiv) Eligibility of the candidate will be checked in reference to the closing date.
