3. Candidates have to submit Demand Draft on any Nationalized Bank drawn in favour of “**Admission Account, Directorate of Admissions, A.U.**” payable at Visakhapatnam for the prescribed amount. Admission will not be processed without D.D. for the admission fee as specified.
4. All certificates in respect of reservation categories like SC, ST, LBC, Caste conversion, etc., are subject to scrutiny by appropriate Governmental agencies.
