i) Allahabad Bank invites applications for recruitment of 1100 Single Window Operators 'A' (clerical Cadre Post) from Indian citizens who have taken the pre-requisite Common Written Examination (CWE) 2011-12 conducted by the Institute of Banking Personnel Selection (IBPS), Mumbai on 27.11.2011, 04.12.2011, 11.12.2011 & 18.12.2011 for recruitment of Clerks and have a valid Score card issued by IBPS.

ii) Only candidates possessing valid Score Card issued by IBPS Mumbai are required to apply ON-LINE through Bank's website www.allahabadbank.in where full advertisement and Fee Payment Challan are available.

iii) The recruitment will be on State-wise/UT wise basis. Candidates can apply for vacancies in one State/UT only and should have appeared for the test, from a centre allotted for that particular State/UT in IBPS Common Written Examination - CLERK 2011-12.

iii) Direct Entry to Interview:

A limited number of eligible applicants who are ranked sufficiently high on the basis of aggregate marks obtained in the Common Written Examination conducted by IBPS, Mumbai and holding valid Score Card issued by IBPS will be called for interview.

a) The candidates are required at first to see the eligibility criteria and if eligible, take a print of the Fee Payment Challan available in Bank's website www.allahabadbank.in, fill in completely, pay the fee and / or intimation charges in cash at any branch of Allahabad Bank in the designated Account No. 5011440153 and obtain receipt with Journal Number mentioned on it, and then apply On-Line through the Recruitment link provided at the Bank's website.

2) **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:**

I. NATIONALITY / CITIZENSHIP : A candidate must be either (i) a citizen of India, OR (ii) a subject of Nepal, OR (iii) subject of Bhutan, OR (iv) a Tibetan refugee who came over to India before 1st January, 1962 with the intention of permanently settling in India, OR (v) a person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka, East African countries of Kenya, Uganda, the United Republic of Tanzania (formerly Tanganyika and Zanzibar), Zambia, Malawi, Zaire, Ethiopia and Vietnam with the intention of permanently settling in India. Provided that a candidate belonging to categories (ii), (iii), (iv), & (v) above shall be a person in whose favour a certificate of eligibility has been issued by the Government of India. A candidate in whose case a certificate of eligibility is necessary may be admitted to the Group Discussion and / or Interview conducted by the Bank but on final selection the offer of appointment may be given only after the Government of India has issued the necessary eligibility certificate to him/her.

Candidates not producing the above certificate will not be considered under the OBC category.

II. MINIMUM AGE AND EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION : (AS ON 01.08.2011)

(i) **Age :** Minimum : 18 Years, Max. : 28 Years. (relaxation in Upper age as per Govt. of India rules)
(ii) **Qualification :** (A) Passed the Common Written Examination (CWE) for Clerks 2011-12 conducted by IBPS, Mumbai and holding a valid IBPS Score Card for the said CWE. Should have obtained a minimum qualifying marks or above in each subject and also minimum cut off in the Total Weighted Standard (TWS) Score as stipulated in Table A & B above for the State/Union Territory, for which candidate is applying.

(D) **Knowledge of official language (read, write & speak) of the state where vacancies are advertised is essential.**

**The percentage of marks shall be arrived at by dividing the aggregate/total marks obtained by the candidate in all the subjects irrespective of optional/additional subjects studied with the aggregate maximum marks of the examination passed for all the years of the examination.

- The relaxation in upper age limit is cumulative (subject to maximum age limit) as per Govt of India guidelines.
 - All person eligible for age relaxation under 4 above must produce the domicile certificate at the time of interview, from the District Magistrate in the Kashmir Division within whose jurisdiction he/she had ordinarily resided or any other authority designated in this regard by the Govt of Jammu & Kashmir, to the effect that the candidate had ordinarily been domiciled in the Kashmir Division of the state of Jammu & Kashmir during 1st January 1980 to 31st December 1989.
 - Persons eligible for relaxation under 7 above, must produce a certificate from the District Magistrate to the effect that they are eligible for relief in terms of the Rehabilitation Package for 1984 Riot Affected Persons sanctioned by the Government and communicated vide Ministry of Finance, Dept of Financial Services communication no. F.No. 9/21/2006-IR dated 27.07.2007.
 - In the case of a candidate who is eligible for relaxation under more than one of the above categories, the age relaxation will be available on cumulative basis with any one of the remaining categories for which age relaxation is permitted as mentioned above in terms of Government guidelines.
 - Above relaxations are available only if the candidates fulfil the various conditions prescribed in the Govt. of India orders and instructions in this regard. To claim relaxation in age, fees etc. reserved category candidates must submit a copy of the relevant certificate in support of his/her claim at the time of Interview.

IV. DEFINITIONS :

- Ex-servicemen:** Only those candidates shall be treated as Ex-servicemen who fulfil the revised definition as laid down in Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, Department of Personnel and Administration Reform Notification no. 36034/5/85/Estt (SCT) dated 27th October 1986 as amended from time to time.
- Disabled Ex-servicemen (DisXS):** Ex-servicemen who while serving in Armed Forces of the Union were disabled in operation against the enemy or in disturbed areas shall be treated as DisXS
- Dependants of Servicemen killed in Action (DXS):** Servicemen killed in the following operations would be deemed to have been killed in action attributable to Military Service- (i) war (ii) war like operations or border skirmishes either with Pakistan on ceasefire line or any other country, (iii) Fighting against armed hostilities in a counter insurgency environment. viz. Nagaland, Mizoram etc. (iv) Serving with peace keeping mission abroad (v) Laying or clearance of mines including enemy mines as also mine sweeping operation between one month before and three months after conclusion of an operation, (vi) Frost bite during actual operations or during the period specified by the Government (vii) Dealing with agitating Para military forces personnel, (viii) IPKF personnel killed during the operation in Sri Lanka.

Note: 1. Candidates still serving in Defence Services and desirous of applying under Ex-servicemen category should submit a certificate from the competent authority that they would be released/retired on or before 31.07.2012. 2. Ex-servicemen candidates who have already secured employment under the Central Government in Group C & D will be permitted the benefit of age relaxation as prescribed for Ex-servicemen for securing another employment in a higher grade or cadre in Group C/D under the Central Government. However, such candidates will not be eligible for the benefit or reservation for Ex-servicemen in Central Govt. jobs. 3. The Territorial Army Personnel will however be treated as Ex-servicemen w.e.f 15.11.1986. 4. An Ex-servicemen who has once joined a Government job on civil side after availing of the benefits given to him/her as an Ex-servicemen for his/her re-employment, his/her Ex-servicemen status for the purpose of the re-employment in Government job ceases.

(ii) Persons with Disabilities (PWD)

(a) Degree of Disability for Reservation :
Under Section 33 of the Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Act 1995 only such persons would be eligible for reservation in services / posts who suffer from not less than 40% of relevant disability and is certified by a Medical Board appointed by the Central/State Govt. Applicants claiming such benefits should produce acceptable certificate in original in support of their claim at the time of Interview conducted by the Bank, if called by the Bank.

(b) Definition of Categories of Disabilities:

- An Orthopaedically Challenged (OC)** person is one suffering from Locomotor Disability or Cerebral Palsy. Persons who suffer from not less than 40% of relevant disability (as certified by a Medical Board appointed by the Central/ State Govt) would be eligible for reservation in services / posts. Locomotor Disability means disability of the bones, joints or muscles leading to substantial restriction of the movement of the limbs or any form of cerebral palsy. Cerebral Palsy means a group of non progressive conditions of a person characterized by abnormal motor control posture resulting from brain insult or injuries occurring in the pre-natal, peri-natal, or infant period of development.
- Deaf & Hearing Impaired (HI):** the deaf are those persons in whom the sense of hearing is non-functional for ordinary purposes of life i.e. total loss of hearing in both ears. They do not hear, understand sounds at all even with amplified speech. Hearing impairment means loss of sixty decibels or more in the better ear in the conversational range of frequencies.
- Visually Impaired (VI):** the visually impaired persons are those suffering from blindness or low vision.
- Blindness** – refers to a condition where a person suffers from any of the following conditions: (i) total absence of sight, (ii) Visual acuity not exceeding 6/60 or 20/200 (Snellen) in the better eye with correcting lenses, (iii) Limitation of the field of vision subtending an angle of 20 degree or worse. Person with low vision – means a person with impairment of visual functioning even after treatment or standard refractive correction, but who uses or is potentially capable of using vision for the planning or execution of a task with appropriate assistive device.

V. RESERVATIONS:

- Reservation for SC/ST/OBC/PWD/Ex-servicemen candidates will be provided as per Government guidelines.
- Fresh / revised Government guidelines / directives on various issues like reservations, relaxations etc., if revised subsequently, will be made applicable while shortlisting candidates for interview as well as for final selection.

3. SELECTION PROCEDURE :

- Two-Tier Process.**
- COMMON WRITTEN EXAMINATION (CWE) CONDUCTED BY IBPS:** Candidates should have appeared at Common Written Examination conducted by IBPS 27.11.2011, 04.12.2011, 11.12.2011 & 18.12.2011, declared as qualified and have a valid Score card issued by IBPS. Candidates should have obtained the minimum category-wise cut-off in the Total Weighted Standard Score (TWS Score) for the State / U.T. applied for on securing the qualifying categorywise marks in each objective test mentioned in Table A & B respectively herein above to become eligible.
 - INTERVIEW TO BE CONDUCTED BY THE BANK :**
Depending upon the number of vacancies, State-wise & Category-wise, only a certain number of eligible applicants in the descending order of Total Weighted Standard Score (TWS Score) in the Common Written Examination (CWE) conducted by IBPS, Mumbai in respective category for the State/ UT fulfilling the cut offs as mentioned above, will be called for Interview at the discretion of Bank.

The interview of 35 marks shall be conducted to assess the attributes of the candidates like intelligence, motivation, communication skills etc. The minimum qualifying marks for interview would be 40% i.e. 14 for General category & 35% i.e. 12 for reserved category candidates. Candidates not qualifying in the interview will not be considered for final selection.

Note: Looking to the requirement and exigencies, Bank may 1) waive / adopt any of the procedures for selection of candidates, 2) relax / increase the cut-offs (TWS Score obtained in CWE) and / or fix the ratio of the candidates to be called for interview. 3) Hold supplementary selection process if necessary.

c) FINAL SELECTION : Final selection will be made State/Union Territory wise. Only those candidates who have secured qualifying marks in each objective test and the stipulated minimum TWS score in the CWE and also the minimum qualifying marks in the interview will be considered for final selection. State-wise final merit list will be prepared in respect of eligible candidates comprising all categories by adding the total weighted standard score (TWS Score) obtained by them in the Common Written Examination (CWE) and Interview marks and the same will be strictly in descending order of merit. In case two or more candidates secure same aggregate marks, they will be ranked on the basis of their seniority in age. Statewise/Categorywise offer of appointment in the Bank's service will be given to the number of candidates equal to the number of vacancies declared strictly in order of merit.

d) PROBATION :

Probation period for Single Window Operator 'A'	6 months
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The candidate will remain initially on probation for a period of six months from the date of joining the Bank's service which may be extended at the Bank's discretion. The confirmation to the permanent establishment of the bank will be considered as applicable in terms of Service Regulations, provided the work, conduct, general ability are found to be of the standard required by the Bank. Confirmation in the service of the Bank will also be subject to receiving satisfactory references from respectable referees, police verification of antecedents, caste/ community verification and other compliances.

4. INTERVIEW CENTRES :

Interview will be held in different centres and the addresses of the venue will be displayed in the Bank's website approximately one week before the date(s) of commencement of Interview.

- Note:**
- Request for change of centre of Interview shall not be entertained.
 - Bank reserves the right to cancel any of the centres and / or add some other centre(s) / or rehold Interview depending upon the response, administrative feasibility, exigencies etc.
 - Identity Verifications : While opening for interview the candidates are requested to produce photo identity such as PAN Card/Passport/Driving Licence/Voter Card/Adhar Card/Bank Pass Book with photos for verification. In case of doubtful identity candidates will not be allowed for interview.

5. IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS :

- Only candidates who have appeared in the Common Written Examination (CWE) conducted by IBPS, Mumbai and are in possession of valid score card with minimum required score as stipulated herein above and possess minimum eligibility under the heading Minimum Age and Educational Qualifications, may apply.
- Payment of application fee and/ or intimation charges by Demand Draft /Cheques/ Money Orders/ Postal Order etc will not be accepted.
- Application once made will not be allowed to be withdrawn and fees once paid will neither be refunded on any account nor can it be held in reserve for any other selection process.
