## **IISc Centenary Post-doctoral Fellowships** & Research Associateships

The Indian Institute of Science (IISc) Bangalore, invites applications for the IISc Centenary Post-Doctoral Fellowships (CPDF) and Research Associateships (RA). Both fellowships are meant to encourage bright, young scientists and engineers of all nationalities to work in the stimulating environment of the IISc. The CPDF will be offered only to the very best and few RA positions will be offered among the remaining, if their applications are judged to be very good.

#### **Duration**

The tenure of fellowship of both programs will be two years. For the CPDF, the period can be extended for one more year depending upon performance.

#### Qualifications

Candidates with a PhD degree (in Science or Engineering) or those who have submitted their doctoral theses can apply.

### **Fellowship Amounts**

Centenary Post-Doctoral Fellowships: ₹ 30,000 to 35,000 per month Research Associateships: ₹ 20,000 to 24,000 per month

The monthly stipend will be based on the years of experience after the submission of the doctoral thesis. Both positions carry an additional 30% housing allowance. In addition, an annual contingency grant of ₹ 50,000 (for CPDF only) will be provided to selected candidates for research-related expenses.



Candidates must provide a 500-word research proposal indicating the research they would like to undertake and the facilities required. Information about IISc is available Selected candidates are expected to carry out at http://www.iisc.ernet.in. independent research but are also required to identify a faculty member at IISc working on their research area for mentoring and logistical purposes. Those who would like to work in an inter-disciplinary area may identify more than one mentor.
