Combined Graduate Level Examination, 2012 (Re-examination) – Declaration of result of Written Examination (Tier II)

The staff Selection Commission conducted re-examination of the Combined Graduate Level (Tier-II) Examination, 2012 on 14th October, 2012 at certain Centres of WR, MPR and CR.

2. The details of candidates who have qualified for Interview/Skill Test for the different posts on the basis of total marks in Tier-I and Papers-I + II of Tier-II are as under:-

(In addition to UR candidates shown in the table, 115 OBC, 8 SC and 1 ST candidates are also provisionally qualifying at UR standard.) .There is 122 common candidates between List-I and List-III, 122 common candidates between List-I and List-IV and 336 common candidates between List-III and List-IV.

3. Candidates declared qualified in List-I will be called for interview. Candidates declared qualified in List-I and who have also opted for the post of Assistant in CSS will be called for Computer Proficiency Test. Candidates declared qualified in List-IV will be called for DEST and Documents verification. Those candidates, who are called for CPT, will not be called for DEST separately and Module-I of CPT will be taken for evaluating their performance against DEST.

4. The above results are based on data sent by Regional Offices of the Commission and are subject to verification of their options furnished in the Application Form. Inclusion of any candidate in any of the list of the post for which he/she has not opted will not confer any right on his/her consideration for any post for which he/she had not exercised option. However, candidates in List-IV who have not opted for the post of Tax Assistant are encouraged to appear for the Skill Test in Data Entry Test for the post of Tax Asstt., as the Commission intends to consider their selection against unfilled vacancy in the post, if any.

5. For CPT, DEST/Document Verification and Interview Schedules, candidates are advised to follow websites of the regional offices.

6. Representations received from candidates about incorrect answer keys and their answers to the question paper used by the Commission in this Examination have been carefully examined in consultation with experts wherever necessary and answer keys modified wherever representations were found to be genuine. The modified keys were used for evaluation.

7. Marks of the qualified/non-qualified along with changes in keys would be available only on the website shortly. The result is available on the Commission's website <http://ssc.nic.in>.
