B. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION TO MCA COURSE:

- I. Admission to the Master in Computer Application (MCA) Course for the academic session 2012-13 being offered in the institutions administered by and affiliated to Punjab Technical University, Jalandhar, Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar, Punjabi University, Patiala shall be made through the "Punjab Admission to MCA Common Aptitude Test –2012 (PAM-CAT 2012).
- II. 85% seats shall be open to the candidates from the State of Punjab and 15% will be open to candidates from outside the State.
- III. To be eligible for the 85% seats a candidate shall be a resident of Punjab State as per Punjab Government, Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms (PP II Branch) letter No. 1/3/95-3PP/9619 dated 6th June 1996 and letter No. 1/3/95-3PP/80 dated 1st January 1999, or shall have passed graduation from a University or institution recognized by UGC and situated in Punjab. Each candidate shall be required to submit a certificate to this effect from the Principal/ Head of Institution last attended on the prescribed proforma.
- IV. The eligibility criteria for admission including educational qualification, as specified by Punjab Technical University, Jalandhar, Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar and Punjabi University, Patiala shall be applicable for admission to the Institutions/colleges affiliated to these respective universities.
- V. Apart from the basic educational qualifications, the general eligibility criteria shall be as mentioned in Punjab Government, Department of Technical Education & Industrial Training, Punjab, **Memo No. 35/44/95-1T(2)/978 dated 21st March, 2003.**
- VI. In case the candidates from entrance examination i.e. **PAM-CAT – 2012** are not available and seats are still vacant, admission can be made on the inter-se-merit of the qualifying examination.
- VII. The students shall be liable to pay fee/development fee and other charges, as per the rates of fee/development fee and other charges as fixed by the Government of Punjab and the concerned University, from time to time.
- VIII. The fee structure for Foreign Nationals/Persons of Indian Origin shall be the same as is in vogue for NRI candidates.
- IX. The guidelines for admission of Foreign Nationals/ Persons of Indian Origin shall be as per Punjab Government Notification No. 13/75/2001-ITE2/296 dated Chandigarh the 23rd January, 2002.

C. ELIGIBILITY FOR PAM-CAT-2012

- I. All those candidates who have passed Bachelor's Degree of minimum 3 years duration in any discipline with 50% (45% in case of candidate belonging to reserved category)- from a University recognized by the University Grants' Commission (UGC) and have with Mathematics at 10+2 School level or have passed BCA course of minimum three year duration from a University recognized by the University Grants' Commission (UGC).
- II. The Punjab Technical University, Jalandhar shall decide the conditions and modalities for the conduct of PAM-CAT-2012, alongwith the centers for the conduct of examination.
- III. There shall be no cut-off marks in the **PAM-CAT - 2012**. However, only those candidates who appear in the **PAM-CAT - 2012**, and who have otherwise not been disqualified and whose rank has been declared by the PTU, Jalandhar shall be eligible to appear in the counselling in the order of PAM CAT-2012 merit/ rank, subject to their having passed the basic qualifying examination. Merely applying for, but not appearing at the **PAM-CAT – 2012** shall not be sufficient to become eligible for counselling.

D. COUNSELLING:

- I. There shall be a joint counselling by Punjab Technical University, Jalandhar with representatives of the other participating universities.
- II. Counselling for 85% seats for Punjab residents and 15% outside Punjab candidates shall be taken up simultaneously.
- III. Counselling for general category will be held first, followed by counselling for reserved category. The same procedure shall be repeated for second round of counselling.
- IV. The seats which still remain vacant after the second round of counselling shall be transferred to Common Pool, irrespective of any quota or reservation and shall be allotted to available eligible candidates on the basis of their PAM-CAT-2012 rank during the third round of counselling.
- V. The seats, if any, vacant or falling vacant or any drop out vacancy even after third round of counselling, shall be filled by the respective Colleges/ Universities in keeping with the guidelines as applicable to Management Quota seats. However, for the seats transferred to the institutions/ colleges for direct admission, if a candidate belonging to reserved category is available, he/she shall be given preference over the general category candidates in case share of reserved category candidates is less than the prescribed limit/quota.
- VI. A seat once accepted shall not be changed under any circumstances.
- VII. If any new institution is approved or seats are increased/ altered in the existing institutions by the AICTE and such approval is received before the commencement of the counseling, Punjab Technical University, Jalandhar shall

issue a public notice of the same for the information of the candidates. These new institutions as well as additional seats shall be taken into consideration and admission shall be made accordingly. However, if any such approval is received after the last date of counselling, it shall not be taken into consideration and no admission to such institutions shall be allowed or made for the academic session 2012-2013, without a specific order of the Government of Punjab.

- VIII. Punjab Technical University, Jalandhar, shall charge a counselling fee of Rs.3,000/- (Rupees three thousand only) from each student who has enrolled for counselling. Such fee shall be charged once and it shall be non-refundable.
- IX. In case a student changes his/ her college/ university through the joint centralized counselling conducted by PTU, Jalandhar, his/ her fee shall be refunded by the previous institution after deducting Rs.1000/- only and the original documents, if any retained by the previous institution shall also be returned immediately.
- X. In case a student surrenders his / her seat within 7 days of the end of the counselling, he/ she must submit application to the college and PTU, Jalandhar. PTU, Jalandhar shall forward such cases to the concerned Colleges/ Universities for refund of his / her full fee after deduction of Rs. 1000/-only. The surrender of seat thereafter shall be governed by notification regarding refund of fee issued by AICTE vide letter no. AICTE/Legal/ 04(01)/2007 and the same shall be followed strictly.

E. RESERVATION

- I. The reservation of seats shall be as per Punjab Government, Department of Technical Education and Industrial Training **Memo. No. 13 / 2/ 05 -1TE2/409** dated 20th February, 2006, which is attached as Annexure I.
- II. The attention of the applicants desirous of claiming reservation under any category whatsoever is especially drawn to the condition and stipulation that only the certificates that have been produced on date of counselling shall be considered. The candidates are accordingly advised, in their own interest, to get the requisite certificates issued well before the date of counselling, otherwise, claim for reservation shall be summarily rejected.
- III. Candidates are required to claim reservation in the application form. If no reservation is claimed, the candidates shall be treated and considered as a "General Category Candidate".
- IV. The Punjab Technical University, Jalandhar shall make a provision in the **PAM-CAT – 2012** application form for a candidate to indicate the category, if any, under which they are seeking reservation. There shall also be a provision to indicate the sub-category of the category, if any, under which reservation is being sought, so that inter se gradation can be facilitated. These sub-categories have been elucidated in the Punjab Government, Department of Technical Education & Industrial Training **Memo No: 13/2/05-1TE2/409 dated 20th Feb., 2006. which is attached as Annexure-V.** Punjab Government may also set up a Committee to effect inter se gradation of candidates claiming reservation under certain categories, as indicated in the aforesaid memo dated 20th Feb., 2006.
- V. A candidate shall be eligible to make a claim for reservation under one reserved category only. However, the procedure for counselling shall be as per Punjab Government, Welfare Department (Reservation Cell) **Memo No.7/21/ 2004-RS1/1674-1677 dated 20th Dec., 2004.**

F. OVER-RIDING PROVISION:

- I. Nothing in this notification shall be operative in so far as it is inconsistent with the law of the land as laid down in the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case of T.M.A. Pai Foundation and others Vs. State of Karnataka and others ((2002) 8 SCC 481: AIR 2003 SC 355). Any such inconsistency may be brought to the notice of the Government of Punjab, clearly highlighting the inconsistency, for immediate rectification.
- II. The notifications, circulars and instructions of Government of Punjab as referred to in this notification shall be treated as part of this notification, for all purposes and all the provisions in para B-III, B-V, B-IX, E-I, E-IV & E-V of this notification and shall be read alongwith the provisions of the said notifications, circulars and instructions.
- III. The institutions/ colleges covered under this notification which do not make admission on the basis of **PAM-CAT-2012** and centralized admission procedure as indicated in this notification or further elaborated by the Punjab Technical University, Jalandhar from time to time or violate any of the above terms and conditions shall automatically stand dis-affiliated from the concerned university without any further notice.

Subject: Reservation of seats for various categories of candidates for admission to the degree-level courses in Engineering and Technology in various Colleges, including MBC, MCA and B.Pharmacy as well as diploma-level courses in Polytechnic Institutions and certificate courses in I.T.I's in the State of Punjab for the session 2006-07.

Reference Punjab Government Memo No. 13/2/05-1TE2/869 dated 04th

17 April, 2006 on the subject noted above.

2. The aforesaid Reservation Policy has been further reviewed and it has been decided to retain the previous policy in terms of substantive percentages of reservation for the various categories. The percentage of reservation for each of the categories shall be now as under:-

(i)	Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes	25%
(ii)	Backward Classes	5%
(iii)	Border Areas/ Backward Areas (2% each)	4%
(iv)	Sportspersons	2%
(v)	Children/ Grand Children of Freedom Fighters	1%
(vi)	Disabled Persons	3%
	(a) Blind	1%
	(b) Deaf & Dumb	1%
	(c) Other Handicapped	1%

(If suitable candidates are available in any one of these sub-categories, the seats so available will be filled up by the candidates from the other sub categories of disabled candidates and if they are not available in any sub-category then seats shall be filled up from general category candidates).

3. Children/ windows of defence personnel killed or disabled to the extent of 50% or more in action, wards of gallantry awardees, children of serving defence personnel/ ex-servicemen (2%). The priority to this category is given as under:-

- (a) Killed in action.
- (b) Disabled in action & Boarded out of service.
- (c) Died while in service & death attributable to military service
- (d) Disabled in service & Boarded out of service with disability attributable to military service.
- (e) Gallantry award/other award winners both serving/retired.
- (f) Serving Defence Personnel/Ex-servicemen.

4. Children/ widows of Para-military forces personnel, Punjab Police, PAP and Punjab Home Guards killed or disabled in action to the extent of 50% or more; and children of paramilitary forces personnel/ ex-paramilitary forces personnel, wards of Punjab Policemen decorated with Gallantry Medals (2%).
5. November 1984 riots-affected displaced persons, children of the Army deserters Killed/ 100% physically disabled, children of the families of persons killed as a result of terrorist violence or by security forces acting in aid of civil authorities and the children of innocent civilians who have sustained 100% disability in terrorist violence or during operation by Security forces acting in aid of civil authorities (2%).
6. The reservation for T-Sunami affected persons shall be available for children/grand children of original Ex-servicemen settlers of Campbell bary Island only (1%).
7. The aforesaid percentage reservation in respect of each category shall, however, be subject to the detailed clarifications and *inter se* graduation criteria as decided in the meeting chaired by Chief Secretary to the Government of Punjab on 13th March, 2003, the minutes of which are appended. These minutes and the decisions recorded therein shall be treated as a part and parcel of this communication.
8. Nothing in the aforesaid policy shall apply to the courses run by the three universities in the state, other than Punjab Technical University, Jalandhar, in respect of the courses offered by them in their campuses or their regional centers. Admission to these courses shall be governed by the reservation policy framed by the respective University.
9. These policy instructions shall be subject to the law laid down by the honorable Supreme Court of India in the case of TMA Pai Foundation and others V/s State of Karnataka and others ((2002) 5SCC 481: AIR 2003 SC 356).
10. You are requested to implement the above reservation policy in all the Professional/ Engineering Colleges/ Polytechnic Institutions/ Industrial Training Institutes and Technical Institutes in the State.
