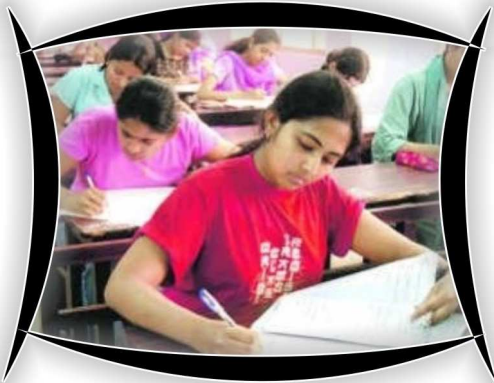
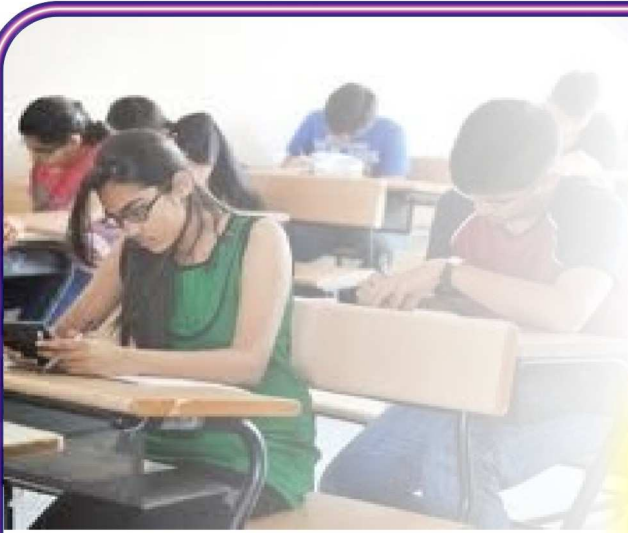

I. About COMEDK

1. COMEDK is the “Consortium of Medical, Engineering and Dental Colleges of Karnataka” to determine the merit of students seeking admissions to the undergraduate courses in the Member Institutions of the Karnataka Professional Colleges Foundation Trust (KPCF) in its endeavor to offer an effective, fair, transparent and non-exploitative testing procedure. There are 12 Medical, 25 Dental and more than 150 engineering colleges who make available almost 20,000 seats for admission.
2. COMEDK has been assigned the task of organizing a Common Entrance Test for the academic year 2013-2014. The COMEDK Entrance Test being considered as an exercise to shortlist an inter-se merit of candidates for grant of admission in a fair and transparent manner. The publication of test score and rank list will be followed by centralized counseling (Single window system). The details will be published in due course on our website, www.comedk.org.
3. Applicants are advised to read this brochure thoroughly and familiarise themselves with the test procedures. COMEDK’s website www.comedk.org contains information and current updates/alerts. This site is updated regularly. COMEDK suggests all applicants to visit it frequently for relevant information.

III. Eligibility Criteria

Note: The eligibility criteria for Medical, Dental, Engineering and Architecture admission has already been notified on 15/02/2013; however to reiterate the eligibility criteria the same is reproduced here.

4. MBBS / BDS

- a) As per the Regulations of Medical/Dental Council of India, the qualifying examination prescribed for admission to MBBS/BDS is 2nd PUC or 10+2 higher secondary or equivalent examination, recognized by State / Central Government. The last two years of study shall comprise of Physics, Chemistry and Biology (PCB) with English as a compulsory subject.
- b) The General Merit candidates must have passed these subjects (PCB) individually and must have obtained a minimum of 50% of marks taken together in PCB (40% in the case of SC, ST and OBC candidates of Karnataka state); they must also secure not less than 50% marks (40 % in the case of SC, ST and OBC candidates of Karnataka state) in PCB in the Common Entrance Test of COMEDK UGET-2013.
- c) English is one of the subjects to be tested along with Physics, Chemistry and Biology during COMEDK UGET-2013 and the General Merit candidates **should secure not less than 50% marks in English, (40 % in the case of SC, ST and OBC candidates of Karnataka state)**. However, the marks so secured in English will not be added for the determination of rank list as the rank list will be drawn exclusively based on the minimum required marks secured by the candidates in PCB; further, **a candidate is not entitled for a rank if he/she fails to secure 50% or 40% (in the case of SC, ST and OBC candidates of Karnataka state) of marks in English.** The paper on English language will be of Matriculation standard and will test the candidate's comprehension of the language, the structure of words, phrases, clauses, and sentences.
- d) The candidates shall complete the age of 17 years on or before 31st December (31/12/2013) of the year of admission to the MBBS/BDS course.
- e) **Similarly, the candidates who have passed the qualifying examination prior to 2009 NEED NOT APPLY.**

Note: The candidates are advised to refer to COMEDK notification dated 15/02/2013 for understanding various illustrations.

5. B.E:

- a) As per the existing norms of the All India Council of Technical Education (AICTE), the qualifying examination prescribed for admission to B.E. is 2nd PUC or 10+2 higher secondary or equivalent Examination recognized by State / Central Government. The last two years of study shall comprise of Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics (PCM) with English as a compulsory subject.
- b) The General Merit Candidates should have passed with a minimum aggregate of 45% marks (40% in respect of SC, ST and OBC Candidates of Karnataka state) in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics (PCM) and should have passed these subjects individually. Physics and Mathematics are compulsory subjects along with Chemistry or Biotechnology or Biology or any other Technical vocational courses as one of the optional subjects. However, if there are any changes in the eligibility criteria by the AICTE, the same will be adopted.
- c) An attempt in the Entrance Test seeking admission to Engineering courses is considered adequate for figuring in the Rank list.

NOTE: Diploma Candidates are not eligible to take COMEDK UGET-2013 entrance test.

6. B. Arch:

- a) The qualifying examination prescribed for admission to B. Arch is 2nd PUC or 10+2 higher secondary or equivalent Examination with Mathematics as one of the subjects along with other subjects or a 10+3 Diploma recognized by Central / State Government and having obtained at least 50% marks in aggregate (45% marks in case of SC, ST and OBC Candidates of Karnataka).
- b) The candidate should have appeared for National Aptitude Test in Architecture (NATA) conducted by Council of Architecture with a minimum score of 80 out of 200 for both General Merit and Category Candidates.

Note:

- i. **COMEDK will not be conducting any Common Entrance Test for candidates seeking admission to B. Arch (Architecture Course) as per its existing rules.**
- ii. **Candidates seeking B. Arch seats should submit separate application form along with a DD of Rs. 700/- in favour of COMEDK.**

IV. About Member Institutions

7. There are in all 12 medical, 25 dental and more than 150 unaided, private engineering colleges which are members of COMEDK, across the State of Karnataka and which offer various courses in Medical, Dental or Engineering studies at Under-Graduate level. The courses offered at the Under-Graduate level include MBBS, BDS or B.E programs. Colleges have indicated their willingness to make admission to their Under Graduate courses based on merit in the Common Entrance Test organized by COMEDK (COMEDK UGET-2013).

Note:

- Minority status of candidates is applicable for admission to respective minority status colleges.
- **Candidates have to declare their category status while filling the application form. Declaration once made in the application with regard to the category status like SC / ST / OBC and Minority will not be changed subsequently either prior to test or counseling. Hence candidates are cautioned to fill in with great care about the category status.**
- **Applications without duly attested SC/ST/OBC and Minority Certificates shall be treated strictly as belonging to General Merit and no correspondence shall be entertained after the last date (i.e. 15/04/2013). Mere mention of a category either as SC/ST/OBC/Minority without enclosing certificates necessary in this behalf, such applicants will be treated as belonging to General Merit category and no changes or modifications are permissible thereafter under any circumstances.**

VII. Sanctioned Intake and Fee Structure

11. Number of seats available and fee structure in the Member Institution will be notified before counseling.

VIII. COMEDK Under-Graduate Entrance Test - 2013

(COMEDK UGET-2013)

12. The entrance test is being conducted for merit determination for use by COMEDK Member Institutions only. **The COMEDK entrance test is mandatory for candidates seeking admissions for the Under-Graduate courses in these Institutions. The COMEDK UGET-2013 test scores are valid only for admissions during the academic year 2013-2014.**

The COMEDK UGET-2013 will be conducted across the State of Karnataka on Sunday the 12th May 2013.

IX. Applicant Login

13. Applicant login gets activated only after the first stage of application processing is completed which is on receipt of application at COMEDK Office.

14. In addition, candidates have been provided with a facility to check the status of their application at various stages. The candidate will have to click on the link indicating “**Applicant Login**” in the COMEDK website under UGET-2013 link.

15. Candidates can login to the system by entering their Application Number and Date of Birth as mentioned in their application form. After the login is successful, the candidates will be provided with various information such as, one’s application details, latest status of their application, provision to print **Online Test Admission Ticket (Online TAT)**, and other alerts / information as specific to the candidate.

Note: The candidate is hereby cautioned to enter his/her date of birth as per the 10th Standard Marks card only.

X. Online Test Admission Tickets and Related Information

16. Online Test Admission Ticket will be available under applicant login of the COMEDK website from 24/04/2013. Candidates appearing for COMEDK UGET-2013 should download & obtain printout of the Online Test Admission Ticket (Online TAT) for taking the COMEDK UGET-2013 scheduled to be held on 12/05/2013.

17. No Test Admission Ticket will be dispatched either by post or courier or in person to the candidates under any circumstances.

18. Candidates will **not be** allowed to write the COMEDK UGET-2013 **without the print out of Online Test Admission Ticket which is a mandatory document.**

19. The Online Test Admission Ticket gives the details of test centre assigned to the candidate. **The candidates are assigned a test centre which is system generated during the application processing itself, hence no requests for change in test centre or test location would be considered.**

20. Any request for change in the application data (including change of address) if any, during the process of COMEDK UGET-2013 must be intimated through speed post / courier / Email / Fax to COMEDK office to reach not later than 15/04/2013 along with covering letter and the Application Number on it. The

covering letter regarding change request should be duly signed by the Candidate. The onus is on the candidate to check on the acceptance with the COMEDK on the change request.

21. The candidates are advised to verify the below mentioned details in the Online Test Admission Ticket.

- a. **TAT Number.**
- b. **Candidate's Name**
- c. **Candidate's Postal Address and contact details.**
- d. **Candidate's Photo**
- e. **Test Centre details.**
- f. **Test Timings**

In the event of any of the above details missing in the printout taken the candidate have to necessarily contact COMEDK Immediately.

Note: Please re check the website for any changes / updates before leaving your hometown for the test.

XI. Test and Related Information

22. The Entrance Test COMEDK UGET-2013 is mandatory for all candidates seeking admissions to MBBS/BDS/B.E courses in Member Institutions of COMEDK. A merit / rank list is generated based on the candidate's scores in entrance test only.

XII. Test Scheme

23. COMEDK UGET-2013 will have the following papers:

- (i). **For Engineering Course** : Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics as one paper for three hours duration.
- (ii). **For Medical and Dental Courses** : Physics and Chemistry as one paper for two hours duration besides Biology and English as another paper for one and half an hour duration.

(iii). **For Medical/Dental and Engineering courses (Both)** : Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics as one paper for three hours duration besides Biology and English as another paper for one and half an hour duration.

- Candidates are required to mark their answers on an OMR Answer sheet (Optical Mark Reader).
- Each correct answer is awarded one mark.
- No Mark/s will be awarded for multiple marking (**marking multiple responses**) of any question.
- There will be no negative marking.**
- However, in the event of a tie in the score the principle of least negative responses (Number of wrong answers) will be adopted. In addition, if required, other methods may be adapted to break ties vide para-38.

Note : Candidates seeking admission for Medical / Dental courses;

Eligibility in English of 50% for General Merit candidates & 40% for SC, ST and OBC candidates of Karnataka is mandatory for allocation of Rank. However only scores in Physics, Chemistry and Biology of the Entrance Test will be the basis for Ranking.

XIV. Test Locations

24. The COMEDK Entrance Test, COMEDK UGET-2013, will be held in different cities/towns across the State of Karnataka. The test will be held on the mentioned time and date in all the test centres simultaneously. The details of all the test centres will be published online. XV. Instructions for Test Takers

25. Candidates to please note:

- Report **60 minutes** before the commencement of the test (**9:00 AM**).
- The Examination Hall will be opened 30 minutes before the commencement of the test. Candidates are expected to take their seats immediately. If the candidates do not report in time, they are likely to miss some of the general instructions.
- The candidate must show, on demand, the TAT for admission in the Examination Hall. A candidate who does not possess the TAT issued by COMEDK shall not be admitted to the Examination Hall under any circumstances.
- During the examination time, the invigilator will check the TAT of the candidates to satisfy himself / herself about the identity of each candidate. The invigilator will also put his/her signature in the place provided in the TAT and OMR Answer Sheet.
- In the Examination Hall the candidate must find and occupy his / her specific place checking for the TAT number which is pasted. If a candidate is found writing the test from a place which is not assigned to him/her, his/her candidature shall be cancelled.

- f) Test commences at **10:00 AM**
- g) After 10:15 AM **candidates will not be allowed to enter the examination hall to take the test.**
- h) COMEDK is not responsible for any delay by any means of transportation to the city and reaching the test centre beyond the given time and also the candidate will not be allowed to enter the examination hall and take the test in the event of delay. **It is advisable to reach the Test Location a day prior to the examination.**
- i) Candidates are advised in their own interest not to carry any of the personal computational devices, Bluetooth devices, cell phones, any electronic gadgets etc; to the venue of the examination as arrangement for safe keeping of the same cannot be assured.
- j) Candidates must not carry any textual material, printed or written, bits of papers, any electronic gadgets except the Online Test Admission Ticket and a blue/black ball-point pen inside the Examination Hall.
- k) For those who are unable to appear on the scheduled date of the examination for any reason, **re-examination shall not be held by COMEDK under any circumstances.**
- l) It is mandatory for the candidate to bring his/her recent not older than 6 months passport size colour photograph during the conduct of COMEDK UGET-2013. At the back of the photograph, candidate must mention his/her name, and TAT number.

27. OMR Answer sheet: All answers need to be registered on an Optical Mark Reader (OMR) sheet, which is machine read and evaluated. Candidates must **use only black or blue ballpoint pen** for marking their answers on the OMR Answer sheet. Use of pencils or erasers or whiteners is not permitted.

- a) OMR answer sheets will be supplied only at the examination hall. After the test is over, the answer sheet should be given back, before leaving the room. **Candidates are allowed to take the candidate's copy of the OMR answer sheet and the question booklet only on completion of the test duration time.**
- b) Kindly note that the candidates must sign on their TAT and OMR answer sheets in the presence of the invigilator, after the invigilator has verified their TAT. Invigilators will also sign on the column indicating Invigilators Signature on the TAT and OMR answer sheets otherwise; the answer sheets will be invalid and not be considered for processing.
- c) The OMR Answer sheet contains the following fields which have to be filled in neatly and accurately by the candidate with blue/black ball point pen only. Use of pencil on the OMR answer sheet is not allowed. OMR answer sheet filled in with pencil would be rejected for evaluation.

- d) The OMR answer sheet is machine assessed and therefore it should be handled with care. If there is any doubt, please contact the test invigilator immediately.
- e) The COMEDK UGET-2013 test administration is timed. The test session is designed to be completed within the specified time as indicated in this brochure and no compromise will be made on the set time limits. The Chief Superintendent of the test centre is the official timekeeper. Candidates (Test Takers) will not be permitted to continue the test beyond the established time limit.
- f) It is planned to use **biometric verification** during the test session (at the discretion of COMEDK).
- g) Candidates are not allowed to go out of the room temporarily for any reason during the test duration.

XVI. Instructions for Parents / Guardians

28. Parents/Guardians are advised to ensure that their ward should not indulge in unfair means activities/malpractices which breach the examination rules. If any candidate is found to be indulging in any such activity he/she shall be debarred from taking this examination permanently in future and shall also be liable for criminal action and/or any other action deem fit by the COMEDK.

XVII. Grounds for Dismissal

29. The COMEDK UGET-2013 test administrator is authorised to dismiss a candidate from a test session for:

- a) Attempting to take the test for someone else (Impersonation).
- b) Failing to provide acceptable identification proof when asked for.
- c) Creating disturbance at the test venue.
- d) Giving or receiving unauthorised help.
- e) Using any forbidden / unauthorised testing aids, such as personal computational devices, Bluetooth devices, cell phones, any electronic gadgets etc.,
- f) Leaving the test centre before the stipulated time.
- g) Refusing to follow directions as stipulated by the invigilators etc.,
- h) Photographic mismatch / photographs older than six months / smudged / hazy photograph will result in disqualification of the candidates.

Requests for use of toilet during the test are not entertained.

30. Failure to comply with the test procedures and regulations or with the test administrator's directions can result in COMEDK taking action/s that include, but are not limited to, barring candidates from future testing and or cancelling the test scores. No results would be announced in respect of dismissed candidates.

XVIII. Results Publishing

Note : Subject to the orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India

31. Answer Keys and Test scores of all the candidates will be published on the website, www.comedk.org. Clarifications, if any, should be sought within the dates stipulated. Subsequently the final result along with the Merit List will be published which will be binding on all candidates and no further claim would be entertained thereafter. (Please refer to the Calendar of Events for details).

The test results will be published in two stages:

- a) Test Score Publication
- b) Final Merit / Rank List Publication

32. The Final Merit / Rank List will be sent to the regulatory authorities. Individual rank card will be sent to eligible candidates only. The Rank List will be made available in the COMEDK website, www.comedk.org

XIX Test Scores Publishing

- ❖ **Answer Keys** of the COMEDK UGET-2013 will be published on the website only late in the evening, on **12/05/2013**.
- ❖ **Clarifications to the answer keys**, if any, should be sought between **13/05/2013 and 16/05/2013**. (**Communications received after 16/05/2013 will not be entertained**)
- ❖ **Test scores** of COMEDK UGET-2013 will be published on **01/06/2013**.
- ❖ **Clarifications to the Test Scores**, if any, should be sought between **02/06/2013 and 05/06/2013**. (**Communications received after 05/06/2013 will not be entertained**)
- ❖ **The Final Rank list** will be published on **11/06/2013**.

33. Applicants seeking any clarifications with regard to:

- a. **Clarification with regard to the Answer Keys: (Ref: Annexure-1 for format)**
Applicants seeking clarifications with regard to answer keys have to write to COMEDK, clearly indicating the grievance and with all necessary enclosures in a prescribed format which can be downloaded from our website. Every answer key for which clarification is sought should be sent to COMEDK office by post along with a **Demand Draft of Rs. 200/- (Rupees Two Hundred only) per Item**, drawn in favour of 'COMEDK', payable at Bangalore. Only if the clarification sought is upheld, the money would be refunded after the COMEDK UGET-2013 process is completed.
- b. **Clarification with regard to the Test Scores: (Ref: Annexure-2 for format)**
Applicants seeking clarifications of Test score a **Demand Draft of Rs.200/- (Rupees Two Hundred only) per candidate**, drawn in favour of 'COMEDK', payable at Bangalore, should be enclosed along with a Candidate copy of the OMR answer sheet. Only if clarification sought is upheld, the money would be refunded after the COMEDK UGET-2013 process is completed.

34. Any request for clarification of answer keys / test scores beyond the last date as stipulated in calendar of events will not be entertained.

35. Any verification/clarification sought by the candidates will be put forth to the COMEDK's academic committee for their consideration and the decision given by the committee will be final and binding on all. No further claims for clarifications will be entertained by COMEDK after the last date, as indicated above.

XX Final Merit/Rank List Publishing

36. The final merit / rank list is generated based on the scores in the entrance test and the same will be published on **11/06/2013**.

37. Candidates who have applied for Medical /Dental stream will not be eligible for a rank if they have not secured 50% marks in English paper in the COMEDK Entrance Examination (40% in case of SC/ST and OBC candidates of Karnataka)

For Medical/Dental candidates:

- ⊕ The principle of least negative responses (**number of wrong answers**) in
1) Biology, 2) Chemistry and 3) Physics
- ⊕ Aggregate marks in Chemistry and Biology in the Entrance Test
- ⊕ Marks in Biology in the Entrance Test
- ⊕ Age of the Candidate, the elder candidate is ranked higher than the younger candidate.

For Engineering candidates:

- ⊕ The principle of least negative responses (**number of wrong answers**) in

Q. When do the Courses begin?

A. Medical and Dental Courses are scheduled to begin from **01/08/2013**.

Engineering and B. Arch courses are scheduled to begin from **01/08/2013**.

Q. What is the eligibility for the courses?

MBBS/BDS

- a) As per the Regulations of Medical/Dental Council of India, the qualifying examination prescribed for admission to MBBS/BDS is 2nd PUC or 10+2 higher secondary or equivalent examination, recognized by State / Central Government. The last two years of study shall comprise of Physics, Chemistry and Biology (PCB) with English as a compulsory subject.
- b) The General Merit candidates must have passed these subjects (PCB) individually and must have obtained a minimum of 50% of marks taken together in PCB (40% in the case of SC, ST and OBC candidates of Karnataka state); they must also secure not less than 50% marks (40 % in the case of SC, ST and OBC candidates of Karnataka state) in PCB in the Common Entrance Test of COMEDK UGET-2013.
- c) English is one of the subjects to be tested along with Physics, Chemistry and Biology during COMEDK UGET-2013 and the General Merit candidates **should secure not less than 50% marks in English, (40 % in the case of SC, ST and OBC candidates of Karnataka state)**. However, the marks so secured in English will not be added for the determination of rank list as the rank list will be drawn exclusively based on the minimum required marks secured by the candidates in PCB; further, **a candidate is not entitled for a rank if he/she fails to secure 50% or 40% (in the case of SC, ST and OBC candidates of Karnataka state) of marks in English**. The paper on English language will be

of Matriculation standard and will test the candidate's comprehension of the language, the structure of words, phrases, clauses, and sentences.

- d) The candidates shall complete the age of 17 years on or before 31st December (31/12/2013) of the year of admission to the MBBS/BDS course.
- e) **Similarly, the candidates who have passed the qualifying examination prior to 2009 NEED NOT APPLY.**

Note: The candidates are advised to refer to COMEDK notification dated 15/02/2013 for understanding various illustrations.

B.E:

- a) As per the existing norms of the All India Council of Technical Education (AICTE), the qualifying examination prescribed for admission to B.E. is 2nd PUC or 10+2 higher secondary or equivalent Examination recognized by State / Central Government. The last two years of study shall comprise of Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics (PCM) with English as a compulsory subject.
- b) The General Merit Candidates should have passed with a minimum aggregate of 45% marks (40% in respect of SC, ST and OBC Candidates of Karnataka state) in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics (PCM) and should have passed these subjects individually. Physics and Mathematics are compulsory subjects along with Chemistry or Biotechnology or Biology or any other Technical vocational courses as one of the optional subjects. However, if there are any changes in the eligibility criteria by the AICTE, the same will be adopted.
- c) An attempt in the Entrance Test seeking admission to Engineering courses is considered adequate for figuring in the Rank list.

NOTE: Diploma Candidates are not eligible to take COMEDK UGET-2013 entrance test.

B. Arch:

- a) The qualifying examination prescribed for admission to B. Arch is 2nd PUC or 10+2 higher secondary or equivalent Examination with Mathematics as one of the subjects along with other subjects or a 10+3 Diploma recognized by Central / State Government and having obtained at least 50% marks in aggregate (45% marks in case of SC, ST and OBC Candidates of Karnataka).
- b) The candidate should have appeared for National Aptitude Test in Architecture (NATA) conducted by Council of Architecture with a minimum score of 80 out of 200 for both General Merit and Category Candidates.

Note:

- i. **COMEDK will not be conducting any Common Entrance Test for candidates seeking admission to B. Arch (Architecture Course) as per its existing rules.**
- ii. **Candidates seeking B. Arch seats should submit separate application form along with a DD of Rs. 700/- in favour of COMEDK.**

Q. Are the admissions open only to Karnataka students?

A. No. Admissions are open to all the students across the country.

Q. Are candidates applying from outside the State of Karnataka eligible to get the benefit of lower eligibility qualifying marks?

A. No, only Karnataka candidates belonging to SC, ST and OBC candidate are eligible to get the benefit of lower eligible qualifying marks provided the certificates as applicable issued by the competent authorities is furnished in support of the claim.

Q. Are candidates applying from the Karnataka State eligible to get the benefit of lower eligibility qualifying marks?

A. Yes, in the case of SC, ST and OBC candidates of Karnataka can seek the benefit of lower eligibility in qualifying marks provided the certificates as applicable issued by the competent authorities is furnished in support of the claim.

Q. I have finished my PUC/INTER/HSC/+2 a few years ago. Am I eligible for these courses?

A. Yes. You can apply for the notified courses, if you fulfill the eligibility requirements as mentioned.

Q. Is there an age limit for the course?

A. Yes. He/she shall complete the age of 17 years on or before 31st December of the year of admission to the MBBS/BDS course.

Q. Although I am eligible, I am currently enrolled in another course. Will I be permitted to join?

A. Yes. You are eligible to join if you have the basic eligibility as mentioned.

Q. I have completed my diploma course. Can I apply to COMEDK and its Member Institutions for 2nd year / 3rd semester?

A. No. This notification is only for admissions to the 1st year/semester in MBBS, BDS and B.E Thus; you cannot apply for the 2nd Year (lateral entry scheme).

Q. How will I know my test results?

A. Test results are intimated to candidates. The results are also published on the web site.

Q. When is the last date to apply?

A. Completed application forms must reach the office of COMEDK on or **before Monday the 15/04/2013, by 5:00 PM**. Applications received after the stipulated date and time will be rejected.

Q. I wish to apply for Medical/Dental and Engineering courses. Should I apply for each of them separately or can I apply through a single application for both of them?

A. You can apply to any/all of Medical/Dental and Engineering courses in a single application form. You can indicate your preferences for each of them in the same application form. You have to provide demand draft for Rs. 1,200 in case of you taking only MBBS/BDS (PCB) or B.E (PCM). In case you are taking all the four subjects MBBS/BDS and B.E (PCMB) you have to send a demand draft for Rs. 1500.

Q. Is there any minimum marks to be scored in COMEDK UGET-2013?

A. **MBBS/BDS:** To become eligible for the rank the candidate has to get 50% marks in English (40% in case of SC, ST and OBC candidates of Karnataka) and then A candidate is required to secure a minimum of 50% marks in PCB in the COMEDK UGET-2013 (40 % in case of SC, ST and OBC candidates of Karnataka) to be eligible for admission to M.B.B.S/BDS.
