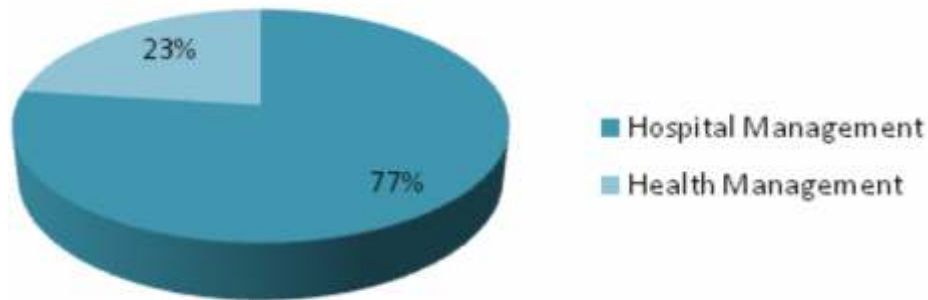

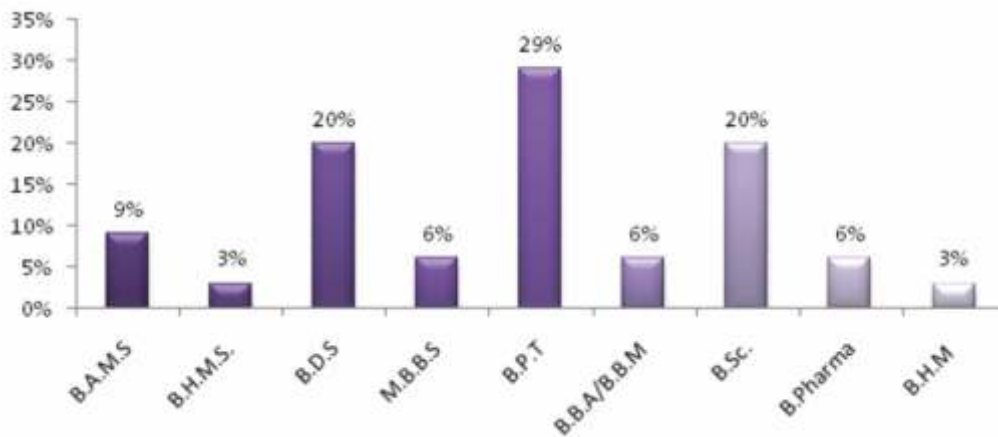

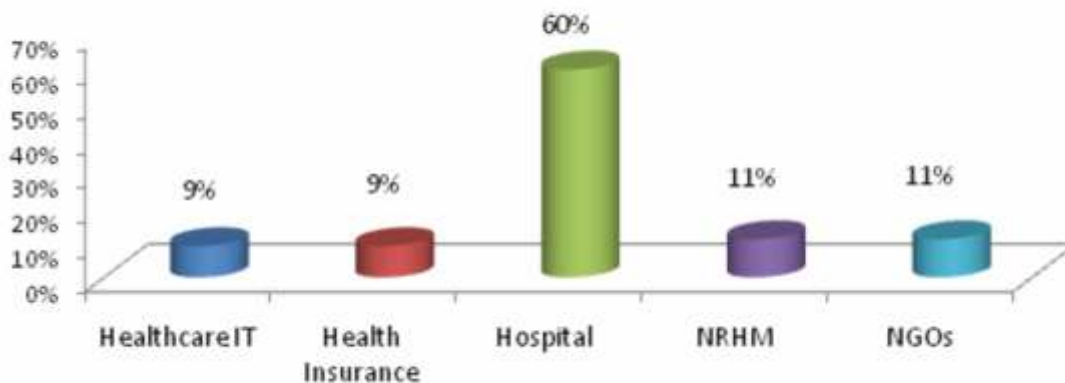
## Distribution of Students by Specialisation

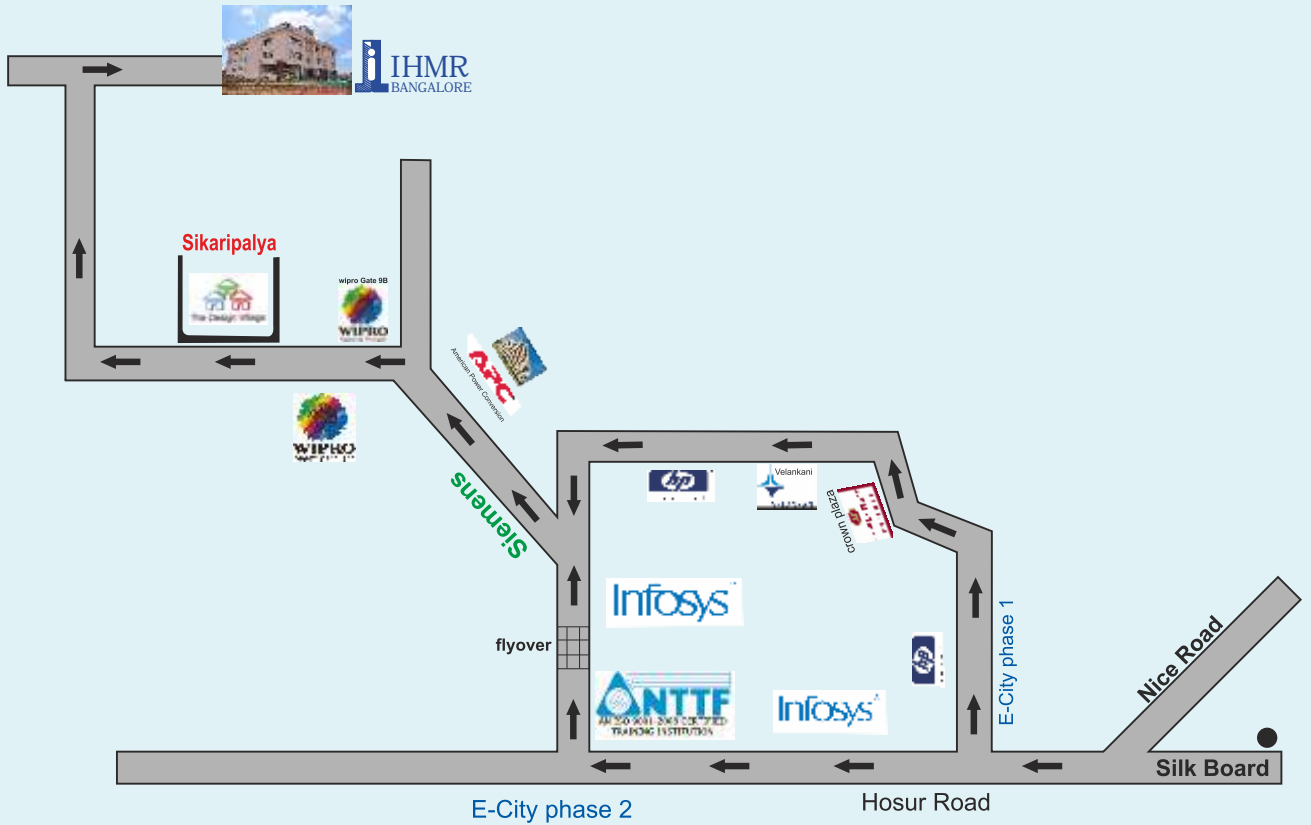
