- Podium finish: 1st and 2nd

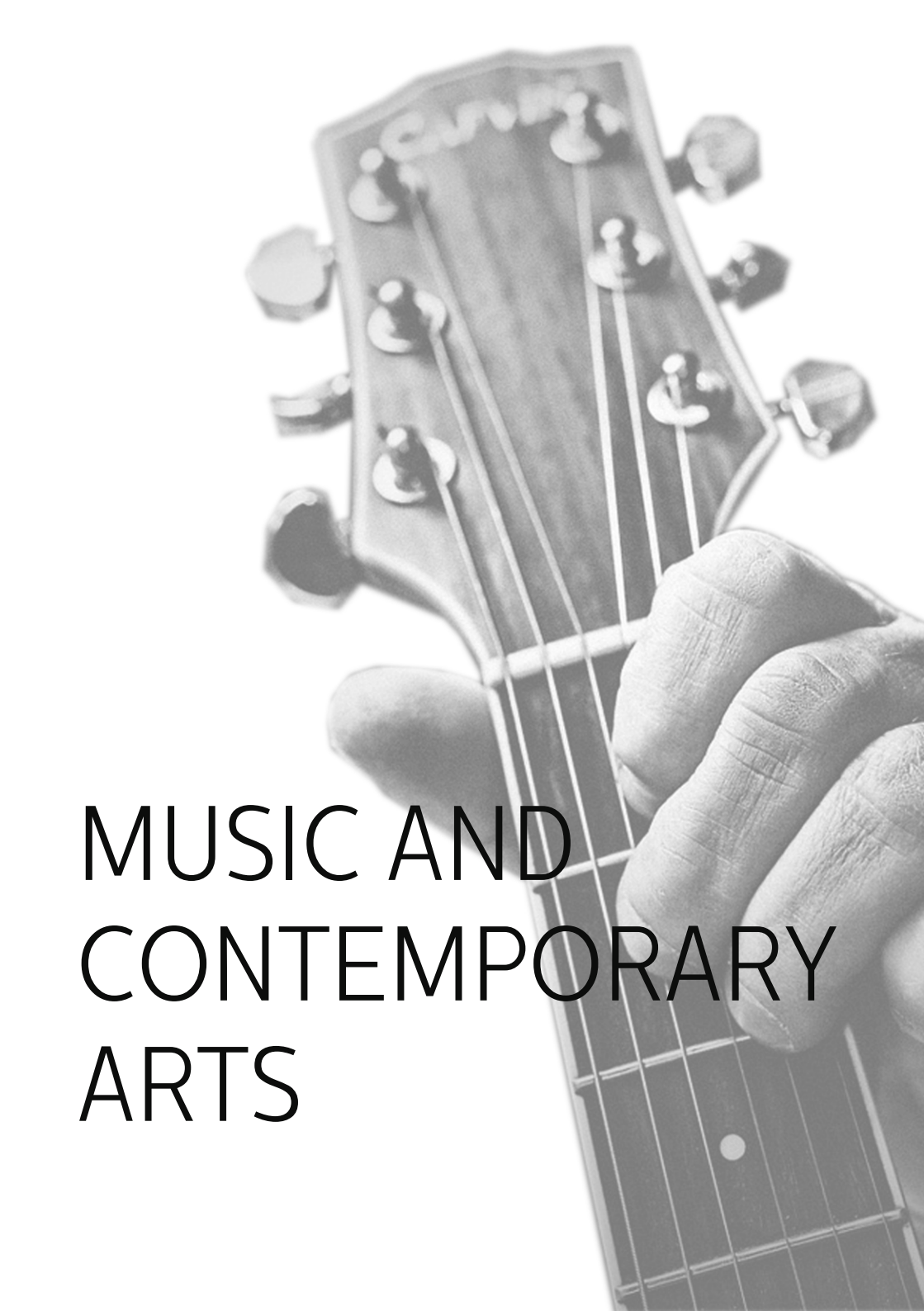

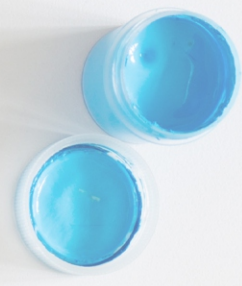

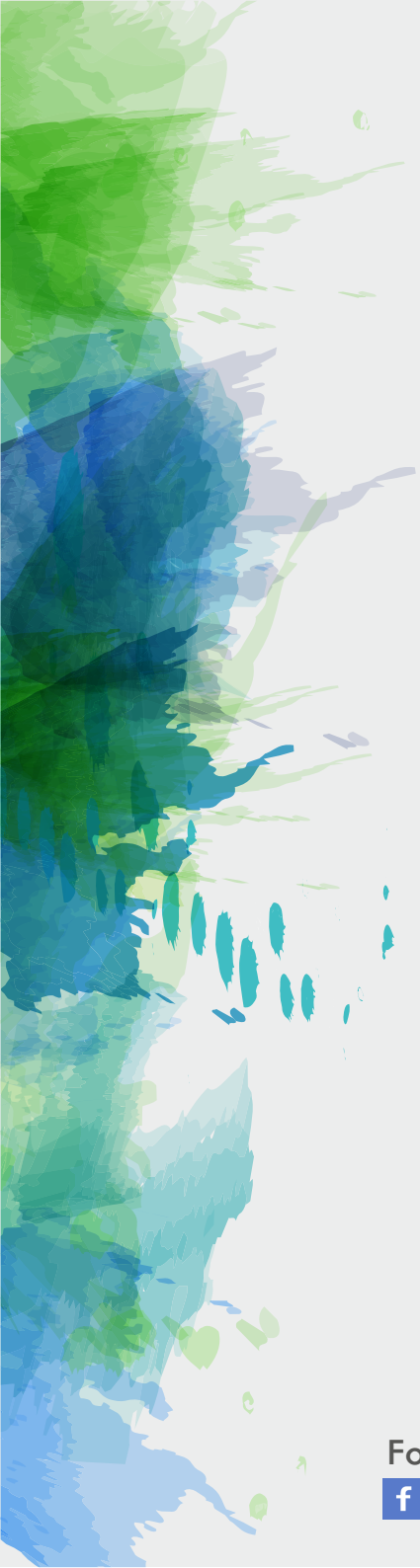
