NOTIFICATION FOR Ph.D. ENTRANCE EXAM 2015-2016

Applications are invited from Indian Nationals for Ph.D Entrance Exam 2015 of the University of Mysore in various subjects. List of subjects is available on website of University of Mysore. It should be noted that successful completion of entrance exam just implies only **the eligibility of a candidate for admission to Ph.D. degree program of the Univeristy, but shall not guarantee an admission to Ph.D. Degree program.** Details are available in the Ph.D Regulations – 2013 (Amended) (See the website <http://uni-mysore.ac.in>).

Eligible applicants can apply online. The candidates should check eligibility exemptions before applying only through the website <http://uni-mysore.ac.in>. The application forms will be available in the website from **23.11.2015** onwards upto **5 PM on 15.12.2015**. The candidates should fill up the online application form and upload online only. **The duly filled in application form along with scanned copy of bank challan must be submitted online on or before 5 PM on 18.12.2015.**

The Entrance Test is scheduled to be held on **16th, 17th and 18th January, 2016** at various centers in India. For further details (including the syllabus for the entrance test) the candidates are advised to visit <http://uni-mysore.ac.in>

A. Conditions of Eligibility:

1. Candidates who have secured atleast 55% of aggregate marks (50% for SC/ST/Cat-1 /Physicaly Challenged candidates) or equivalent grade under grading system, in their Master's Degree or equivalent examination from the recognised Universities/Institutions.

2. The candidates have to satisfy other eligibility conditions as stipulated in the regulations.

B. Exemptions:

The Following candidates are exempted from the entrance exam and they can apply for Provisional Registration by consulting a guide in the subject of their interest after verifying their eligibility.

- (a) Candidates who have qualified for UGC/CSIR (JRF) Fellowships **OR** qualified for Lecturership through UGC/CSIR NET Examination/ K-SET/ GATE **OR** Government/Aided College Teachers under FIP.
- (b) Candidates who have completed M.Phil course, provided their M.Phil course **was through an Entrance Examination.**
- (c) Foreign Nationals with Indian/Foreign Degrees.

C. Syllabus and question paper for Ph.D. Entrance Test:

a) Syllabus:

Note: RGNF/MANF/Project Fellows are not exempted from Ph.D Entrance test.

Syllabus for the entrance test is available subject-wise on the University website.

b) Question Paper Pattern:

1. One question paper per subject with one hundred questions (100) with four choices out of which one is the correct answer.
2. Maximum marks shall be **100 (one hundred)** and the time available for answering questions shall be **2 (two) hours** only.

D. Procedure for applying online:

See the website- <http://uni-mysore.ac.in>, fill in the application online after registration, pay the application fee, upload scanned copy of bank challan and submit completed application form online only.

Application fee per paper:

- a)General merit candidates: Rs. 2000/-
b)SC/ST/Cat-1/PC candidates: Rs.750/-

The Bank challan can be downloaded from the University website <http://uni-mysore.ac.in> and payment can be made only through challan in any of the banks listed. No other mode of payment is accepted. Scanned copy of challan after payment has to be uploadad to complete the application process.

E. General Instructions:

1. There is no upper age limit for applying for the Ph.D entrance test.
- 2.Foreign Nationals with Indian/Foreign Degrees have to contact the Director, International Center, University college of Fine Arts Premises, Manasagangotri, Mysuru-570006, and submit the Application for admission to Ph.D Degree. These candidates are expected to follow the overseas student's admission norms (for example – Equivalence certificates, award of scholarships from host country etc.,) in addition to the norms of 2013 Ph.D. Regulations of the University of Mysore.
3. Any correspondance with regard to Ph. D. Entrance exam must be addressed to the Co-ordinator, Ph.D Entrance Cell, Research Division, University of Mysore, Pareeksha Bhavan (Behind Crawford Hall), Mysuru-570005.

Note: Ph.D Entrance Test will be held through computer based online only.

Please note that candidates/research Supervisors are required to adhere strictly to the Ph.D regulations.
