Applications (Offline mode) are invited from **male & female** Indian citizens (including a subject of Nepal & Bhutan) for filling up **104** vacancies to the post of Constable (GD), Group ‘C’ (non-Gazetted & non-Ministerial), on temporary basis likely to be permanent in ITBPF against Sports Quota. The post has All India liability and selected candidates can be posted anywhere in India and even abroad. On appointment, the candidate shall be governed by the ITBPF Act and Rules and other Rules applicable from time to time. On appointment they shall be entitled for the pension benefits as per the ‘New Restructured Defined Contributory Pension Scheme’ applicable for the new entrants to the Central Government Services w.e.f. 01.01.2004. The last date for receipt of applications is **31.10.2016** for all States except for Assam, Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram, Manipur, Meghalaya, Nagaland, Tripura, Sikkim, and Ladakh Division of Jammu & Kashmir State, Lahaul-Spiti District and Pangi Sub-Division of Chamba District of Himachal Pradesh, Andaman & Nicobar Islands and Lakshadweep for which last date is **07.11.2016**.

5. **ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS:-**

(1) **Age** - 18 to 23 years (Cut off date for determining the age will be **31.10.2016**)

- (a) Upper age limit is relaxable for SC/ST by five (5) years and for OBC by three (3) years.
- (b) Upper age limit is relaxable up to 05 years for Departmental candidates with three years continuous service and in addition 5 years age relaxation for Scheduled Caste or Scheduled Tribe and 3 years for Other Backward Classes who compete alongwith candidates from open recruitment.
- (c) Upper age limit is relaxable upto 5 years in case of the children and dependent family members of those killed in 1984 riots and riots of 2002 in Gujarat. SC/ST/OBC relaxation as per Govt. instructions will be in addition. - (b) A colour blind person shall not be eligible for recruitment. If a person is found to be colour blind at any stage of service career, he/she shall be boarded out as per **SHAPE** policy in vogue;

11. **SELECTION PROCESS:-**

The eligible candidates shall be issued Admit cards to appear in recruitment test. The date and place of recruitment test will be indicated in Admit card. Candidates will have to undergo the following Tests:-

- a) **Checking of documents:-** The candidates will required to produce the original and attested photocopies of the documents related to his/her education qualification, proof of Date of birth, etc as mentioned in Para-10 above and also submit Sports achievement Certificates of the Sports discipline as per para-5(3). The original documents will be returned to the candidate on the spot after verification.
- b) **Physical Standard Test (PST) -** Candidates found eligible in documentation will be screened for height, chest (chest measurement for male candidates only) and weight measurements by the Board. Those who do not meet the required physical measurements shall be eliminated at this stage.
- c) **Physical Endurance Test (PET):-** Candidates who qualify in documentation and PST will undergo **01 mile race to be completed** within 06 minutes 30 seconds (**for male**) and within 08 minutes 30 seconds (**for female**). No marks will be awarded for this test and PET will be qualifying in nature. The departmental candidates who have qualified Physical Test at the time of their appointment in the Force are not required to appear in the Race event.
- d) **Trial Test:-** Trial Test in respect of game for which a candidate has applied shall be taken to evaluate his/her performance of respective discipline/event by the Recruitment Board.
- e) **Merit List –** Merit list will be drawn on the basis of marks obtained in the Trial Test, which shall include Sports achievements, performance in Trial Test and Technical opinion of the Trial Test Board.

In case of tie in marks, the candidate with higher marks in Sports achievements will be higher in merit. In case tie continues candidate younger in age will be higher in the merit. In case tie continues candidate whose name comes first in the alphabetic order (English) will be kept higher in the merit list.

12. **Detailed Medical Examination (DME):-** Candidates shortlisted in **order of merit** in each discipline/event will be put through Detailed Medical Examination to assess their fitness as per existing policy.

13. **Appeal against Detailed Medical Examination:-**

- i) A candidate declared unfit in detailed medical examination, if not satisfied with the findings of the Medical Officer, can submit an **appeal for his Re-Medical Examination (RME) with a duly filled Medical certificate as per Annexure-VI.**
- ii) The medical certificate shall not be taken into consideration unless it contains a note by the medical practitioner concerned to the effect that it has been given in full knowledge of the fact that the candidate has already been rejected as unfit for appointment in ITBP by a Medical Officer.
- iii) The appeal shall also not be taken into consideration unless it contains:-
- a) **Medical Re-Examination Fee of Rs. 25/-** in form of Indian Postal Order in the name of the **IG, Training Zone, ITB Police Force, Block No. 4, CGO Complex, Lodhi Road, New Delhi-110003.**
- b) Rejection slip (in original) issued by the Presiding Officer during detailed medical examination.

- c) Self addressed Envelop with Rs. 5/- postage stamp affixed on it. Candidates are advised to affix stamp of Rs. 25/- **or** Rs. 40/-, if they desire that Call Letter for R.M.E. is to be sent by Registered post **or** speed post.
- iv) The appeal complete in all respect should be received by **the IG, Training Zone, ITB Police Force** within 15 days from the date of D.M.E. The appeals received after the prescribed 15 days or without relevant documents/incomplete documents shall not be entertained.
- v) The decision of the R.M.E. Board of ITBP shall be final and no Second appeal will be entertained as per Govt Instruction. No reply of the correspondence for Second appeal will be entertained/considered/given.

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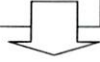

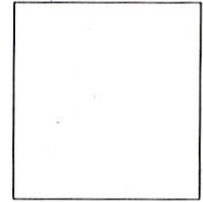
