Bharat Sanchar Nigam Ltd. (BSNL) will conduct a Special Recruitment Drive (SRD) for Persons With Disabilities (PWD) candidates for filling up 23 posts of Junior Telecom Officer (Telecom) {JTO (T)}. All PWD candidates fulfilling the prescribed eligibility conditions and possessing qualification as detailed in **Annexure-A** are eligible to apply for the above said post.

In respect of PWD persons, candidates with following disabilities will be permitted:-

Hearing Impairment

Partially deaf

Locomotor Impairment

One arm or one leg or both legs affected


Degree of Disability for PWDs: In case of PWD candidates only such persons would be eligible for reservation in service/posts, who suffer from not less than 40 percent of relevant disability. Candidates would have to submit a Disability Certificate issued by a Competent Authority in the Annexure-E.

#### Scale of Pay:-1.

The Junior Telecom Officer (Telecom) shall be appointed in the IDA pay scale [E-1] of Rs 16,400-40,500/- with annual increment @ 3% of basic pay plus IDA, HRA, Perks, Medical Benefits, etc. admissible as per company rules.

#### Selection for a Particular Circle & Service liability:-2.

The BSNL comprises a number of territorial Circles and functional Circles. A list of the existing territorial Circles, their respective headquarters etc., appears in Annexure 'B'.

The Junior Telecom Officer (Telecom) is a Circle-based Cadre and the candidates would be selected against the vacancies of a particular Circle. The candidates are required to serve minimum of 5 years in that particular Circle only or until they are promoted to All India Cadre, whichever is earlier. However, BSNL has the right to post any selected JTO (T) to any of the Circles either temporarily or on permanent basis. The decision of BSNL in this regard shall be final and binding. The service conditions, seniority etc. of selected candidates will be determined as per prevailing rules of the Company from time to time.

#### Eligibility:-3.

- Nationality: Only Indian Nationals would be eligible to apply. 3.1
- Educational Qualifications: Applicant must possess the educational qualifications as given in 3.2 Annexure-A, on the closing date of application for JTO (T) Exam in BSNL.

# 4. (a) Age:-

Candidate shall not be below 18 years and not exceed 30 years as on the closing date of the receipt of the Online applications from the candidates (as on 10<sup>th</sup> December, 2015). However, the upper age limit is relaxable as per the standing instructions of Government of India for the following categories :-

- Upto five (5) years for PWD category OC candidates i)
- Upto ten (10) years for PWD category SC/ST candidates ii)
- Upto eight (8) years for PWD category OBC candidates iii)

Note: The date of birth entered in matriculation or Secondary School Leaving Certificate or in a Certificate recognized by an Indian University as equivalent to Matriculation or in an extract from a Register of Matriculates maintained by a University, which must be certified by the proper authority of the University or in the Higher Secondary or an equivalent examination certificate. The certificates are required to be submitted only at the time of document verification. No other document relating to age like horoscopes, affidavit, birth extracts from Municipal Corporation, Service records and the like will be accepted.

#### Disqualifications: No person 4.

Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or (i)

Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted marriage with any person; Shall be eligible for appointment.

Provided that the Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule

# 5. Mode of selection and nature of Question Paper:

The mode of selection is through an All India Competitive Examination. The examination will consist one paper of three hours duration having objective type multiple choice questions, which is to be conducted through Online examination mode.

## 6. Scheme of examination & Syllabus:

The pattern of the question paper will be multiple choice objective types with negative marking. All candidates will undergo a common multiple-choice type examination of three hours consisting of the following three sections:

Syllabus for each of the three sections has been detailed in Annexure-C.

### 7. Minimum qualifying standards

BSNL may fix at its discretion minimum qualifying marks for each section as well as in the aggregate. Candidates obtaining less than minimum-qualifying marks in any of the sections or in aggregate shall not be considered for inclusion in the merit-list.

BSNL reserves the right to change the number of vacancies of JTO (T) as per Circle's requirement.

The appearance of the name in the merit-list does not confer any right on the candidate for employment. A final call letter/ appointment letter will be issued to the candidate after completion of all other formalities.

No request for revaluation of answer books shall be entertained under any circumstance.

## 8. Bond and Training

- (i) The candidates selected shall execute a Bond in the format as specified by the Company to serve in BSNL for a period of five years from the date of their appointment as Junior Telecom Officer (Telecom).
- (ii) The candidates selected shall have to successfully undergo training as per the training plan laid down by the Company.

# 9. Choice of Examination Centre

The JTO (T) Exam will be held in **25** BSNL Territorial Circles only at their respective headquarters. The details of the Territorial Circle where the examination will be conducted are given in **Annexure-B**.

# 10. Online Application and Fee for examination:

Candidates applying for Junior Telecom Officer (Telecom) {JTO (T)} posts are required to apply online for which link shall be provided through BSNL web site <a href="www.externalexam.bsnl.cc.">www.externalexam.bsnl.cc.</a>. Applications will be considered only through the online registration process which is to start from 01-12-2015 and will be closed on 10-12-2015. Therefore, candidates are advised to visit our web site (www.bsnl.co.in/) for any updates regarding Examination. All candidates applying for JTO (T) posts are required to read all the instructions provided on website <a href="www.externalexam.bsnl.co.in">www.externalexam.bsnl.co.in</a> before filling the online application form. Candidates will have to provide valid Email ID and Mobile Number at the time of online Registration.

# Fee:-

The prescribed examination fee Rs.750/-(Rupees Seven Hundred Fifty only) for the candidates shall be paid through online mode i.e. Internet Banking, Credit Card, Debit Card only.

The amount of the fee shall not be accepted in any other form. Fee once paid shall NOT be refunded under any circumstances nor can be held in reserve for any other examination or selection.

# 11. Closing date for receipt of Online Registration Forms

- Registration forms complete in every respect must be submitted Online on or before 10-12-2015. Candidates are advised to complete their registration process well before last date to avoid last day. Registration process will not be allowed after last date and all incomplete registrations will be treated as rejected. Candidates will have to download their Admit Card from the BSNL website www.bsnl.co.in / www.externalexam.bsnl.co.in at least before 5 days from the date of the Written Test by using their user name & password. It will not be sent either by post or by e-mail. BSNL shall not be responsible for server crash problems or delays occurring on last day of registration.
- (ii) The applicants would be admitted to the examination on the basis of the information furnished by them in their registration form. They are, therefore, advised to ensure that they fulfill all eligibility conditions before applying. In case it is found at a later stage that the information furnished by an applicant is false or an applicant does not fulfill any of the eligibility conditions, the candidature of such applicants would be cancelled and no correspondence in this regard would be entertained. Issuance of an admit card for the examination will NOT confer any right for appointment. Appointment will be solely subject to fulfillment of all eligibility conditions.



# 12. Travelling Allowance

- 12.1 The candidates belonging to SC/ST categories will be entitled to TA as per provisions of Ministry of Finance (Department of Expenditure) O.M. No. 19014/3/77-E.IV (B) dated 17/02/1978, as amended from time to time.
- 12.2 The unemployed SC/ST candidates called for the Written Test shall be entitled for reimbursement of second class (Sleeper) rail fare from their place of residence to the nearest Examination Centre, subject to production of ticket.
- 12.3 The SC/ST candidates also have to produce a certificate of unemployment issued by MP/MLA or a designated Government Officer of the place where the candidate normally reside.
- 12.4 The form for reimbursement of TA in respect of SC/ST candidates for attending Written Test is given at **Annexure-D**.
- 13. No request for withdrawal of candidature received from a candidate will be entertained under any circumstances. Any dispute in regard to the recruitment will be subject to the Courts/Tribunals having jurisdiction at New Delhi.
- **14.** BSNL reserves the right to modify/amend any of the terms & conditions of this recruitment at any point of time.

# 15. Disqualification

'Violation of any of the instructions issued along with the admission certificate or at any other stage will be liable the candidate to be disqualified in the examination.'

#### **SCHEME**

- A. Engineering Stream Section I
- E. Engineering Stream Section II
- C. General Ability Test Section III
- 1. The standard of paper in Engineering subjects will be that of Engineering Degree Examination of an Indian University.
- 2. In the general ability test, special attention will be paid to assess the candidate's capacity for general awareness. The standard of paper in general ability test will be such as may be expected of an Engineering Graduate.
- 3. The syllabus for engineering stream papers will be as given below.

# 1. Materials and components

Structure and properties of Electronic Engineering materials, Conductors, Semiconductors and Insulators, Magnetic, Ferroelectric, Piezoelectric, Ceramic, Optical and Superconducting materials. # 2. Physical Electronics, Electron Devices and ICs

Electrons and holes in semiconductors, Carrier Statistics, Mechanics of current flow in a semi-conductor, Hall effect; Junction theory; Different types of diodes and their characteristics; Bipolar Junction transistor; Field effect transistors; Power switching devices like SCRs, CTOs, power MOSFETs; Basics of ICs-bipolar, MOS and CMOS types; Basics of Opto Electronics.
