- The Easternmost State University of India established in 1965 under the provisions of the Dibrugarh University Act, 1965 enacted by the Assam Legislative Assembly.
- Situated at Dibrugarh, the second oldest town of Assam ( $27^{\circ} 26' 32''$  N  $94^{\circ} 53' 58''$  E) on the bank of River Brahmaputra.
- Well connected with Air (Mohanbari Airport), Railways (NFR- Dibrugarh) and Roadways (NH 37).
- Member of Association of Indian Universities (AIU) and Association of Commonwealth Universities (ACU); degrees recognized on reciprocal basis.
- Re-accredited by NAAC (2009) with CGPA of 2.83.
- The Campus covers an area of about 550 acres with incredible green and blessed with pleasant weather.
- The territorial jurisdiction of the University covers seven districts of upper Assam; i.e. Tinsukia, Dibrugarh, Sivasagar, Jorhat, Golaghat, Lakhimpur and Dhemaji.

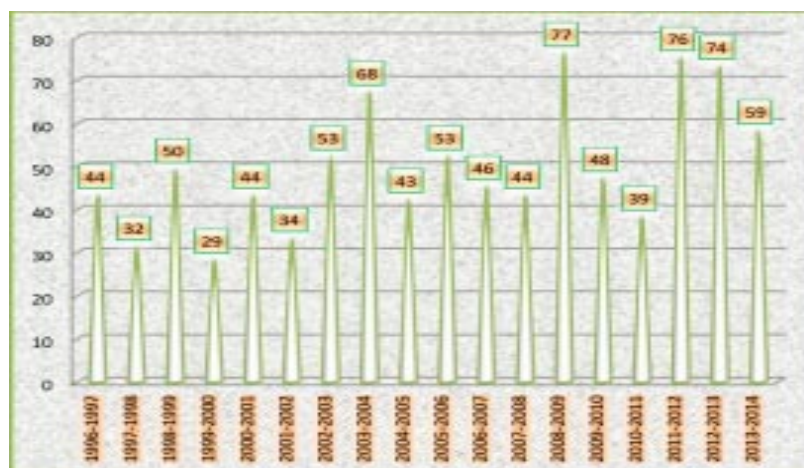

**Training and Placement Cell**

corporate needs, the Cell undertakes different training programmes with outsourced faculty from accomplished National Level trainers.

- ▣ To forge alliance with industry and industrial bodies like FICCI, CII and FID etc.
- ▣ To seek feedback from industry/ employers on performance of students, curricula and infrastructure and appraise concerned authorities.
- ▣ To coordinate soft skill training with Faculties.
- ▣ To maintain updated record about students training and placement activities.

### Choice Based Credit System (CBCS):

Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) has been introduced at Dibrugarh University from the academic session 2009-2010 at the Post graduate levels. This System provides ample scope for strengthening the academic potential of the students as it provides flexibility in the choice of courses within / beyond the framework of the discipline of study. It is a further democratization of higher education with the view to empower students in choosing their special subjects of study, thereby learning a concept or a skill in a field of his / her interest in addition to study of a particular degree course. The Choice Based Credit System is also an effort to match our quality of education to global higher education standards.

### Dibrugarh University Institute of Engineering & Technology (DUIET)

Dibrugarh University Institute of Engineering & Technology is a Constituent College of Dibrugarh University and was established in the year 2009. At present, the Institute offers B.Tech programme in four branches viz. Computer Science & Engineering, Electronics & Communication Engineering, Mechanical Engineering and Petroleum Engineering with an intake 60 in each branch, which are duly approved by the AICTE.



As an integral part of the University, DUIET has been endeavoring to impart quality education through an energetic team of young and promising faculty as well as by the highly experienced and qualified teachers from the various departments of the University. The Institute is enriched with:

## Internet Centre

The Department of Anthropology, Dibrugarh University started functioning in the year 1966, one year after the inception of the University. The Department started with a strong determination to impart Post-Graduate Teaching and Research. Its main aims and objectives have been:

- To impart regular teaching at the Post Graduate level,
- To provide regular supervision and guidance to Ph.D. Programmes having theoretical as well as social relevance.
- To develop human resource with special emphasis on the region where it is located.

The department has built up adequate laboratory facilities for teaching and researches in various branches of Anthropology like Physical and Cultural including Prehistoric Archaeology.





## DEPARTMENT OF APPLIED GEOLOGY



The Department of Applied Geology, a pioneer department imparting Post-Graduate teaching in Geoscience especially in Petroleum Geosciences in the entire North Eastern India since its very inception in 1970. It has a team of efficient and experienced teaching faculties dedicated to meet the country technical manpower needs in various fields of geosciences for management, exploration and production of natural resources and geomaterials. It is a DST -FIST sponsored and UGC DRS-SAP financed Department. Presently the department is offering three parallel programmes. Oil India Limited had instituted the K.D. Malavya (KDM) Chair in 1993 for pursuing research related to the field of Petroleum Geo-sciences.

## DEPARTMENT OF ASSAMESE



The Department has a unique position in the University in terms of its academic performance and substantial contribution in producing quality human resources. Since the very beginning, the department has served a lot to Assamese Language Literature, Culture, History, and to the society as a whole. It is also engaging its resources in research and development related with the language and culture of the varied ethnicity of the North-East region. Most of the faculty members of the department are erudite scholars in their respective discipline and are contributing their best for the well being of the students. It is the first department in the University to receive the status of 'Department of Special Assistance' (DSA) programme (Phase-I) from the UGC in the year 1992 for a term of five years and on successful completion of the DSA Phase-I, it received the DSA (Phase-II) in the year 2000 for another term of five years. In the year 2006, the department was awarded by the UGC with the 'Assistance for Strengthening of the Infrastructure of the Humanities and Social Science (ASIHSS) programme' for a period of five years and completed the term successfully. In the year 2007, the department received the UGC sponsored 'Centre for Advanced Studies' (CAS) programme for a period of five years and successfully achieved the goal of the programme by completing the 1st phase. The Department of Assamese is the first and the only department of humanities and social sciences amongst all the Universities of North-East India to gain the status of 'Centre for Advanced Studies'.

## DEPARTMENT OF CHEMISTRY



Department of Chemistry was started in 1968. Since inception, the Department has been committed towards generating and disseminating knowledge through teaching, research and extension activities. It has a very active research group working in the areas of Polymer Chemistry, Transition metal and main group Co-ordination Chemistry, Natural Product and Synthetic Organic chemistry, Materials Chemistry, Synthetic Nanomaterials, Coal Chemistry, Theoretical and Computational Chemistry and semiempirical calculations (HMO and Normal coordinate analysis) of inorganic complex compounds. Department is collaborating actively with NEIST, Jorhat and other institutes of national importance. The Department has completed several projects in frontier areas sponsored by DST, CSIR, ISRO, UGC, GBPIHED etc. and being awarded with FIST-IA & IB (2003-2008, 2009-2013) by DST, Govt. of India and SAP-DRS-I (UGC, 2008-2013). The Department is equipped with sophisticated instruments like GC-MS, HPLC, FT-IR Spectrophotometer, UV-Vis Spectrophotometer, Impedance Analyzer, TG-DTA Thermal Analyzer, BET Surface Area Analyser, Electrochemical Analyzer (Cyclic Voltammeter), and Vacuum Coating unit.

## DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION



The Department of Education, one of the oldest departments of Dibrugarh University, started functioning with effect from 20th September 1965. It was started with a teacher-training course called Bachelor of Teaching (B.T) which has been renamed as Bachelor of Education (B.Ed) since 1981-82 session. Till 1968 the Department was known as the 'Institute of Education' and since then it is known as the Department of Education. The Department was raised to the status of "College of Teacher Education" (CTE) in 1989. The M.Ed Course was introduced in 1989, with an intake capacity of 10 students. The M.A. Course in Education was started from the session 1992-93. The Department of Education presently conducts three academic programmes in Education, viz. B.Ed, M. Ed and M.A. in Education. Apart from conducting research leading to the M.Phil and Ph.D. degree in Education, the Department is presently engaged as a Monitoring, Institute by the Government of India, to evaluate the various schemes & activities undertaken under the Centrally - sponsored Projects of SSA and RMSA in the districts of Assam.

## DEPARTMENT OF MATHEMATICS



The Department came into existence in 1967 with a major objective to serve as a centre of academic excellence in the area of Post Graduate education in Mathematics and to provide research facilities for teaching, training and research in this area. Apart from regular courses like M.A./M.Sc., Six -Month Pre-Registration course Work of the Ph.D./M.Phil. Programmes M.Phil, and Ph.D., presently the department is offering classes/ guidance to the students preparing for NET and GATE Examinations also. The department since its inception have organized various Seminars, Workshops, Refresher Courses, Summer Institutes to train the teachers of the region. In 1992 the department was selected under COSIST by UGC. The department is receiving NBHM Book Grants since 1992-93 till to-day. The department is also getting financial support from FIST for infrastructure developments. In 2007, the department was awarded financial assistance under Special Assistance Program (SAP) of UGC for a period of 5 years with Mathematical Modeling as the thrust area. The Department has successfully completed the SAP (DRS-I). The UGC has further approved the department for continuation from DRS-I to DRS-II for a period of 5 years (01.04.2013 to 31.03.2018). The Department has completed two minor research projects funded by UGC, New Delhi and one major research project funded by DAE. Further five major research projects are running in the department Publications of the Faculty during 2013-2014: 36 International and 10 National.

## DEPARTMENT OF PETROLEUM TECHNOLOGY



The Department of Petroleum Technology at Dibrugarh University is one of the oldest departments in India to offer courses in the field of Petroleum Technology, both in upstream (Petroleum Exploration & Production) and downstream (Petroleum Refining & Petro Chemicals). Established in 1969, the original PG Diploma course was upgraded to AICTE and UGC recognized M.Tech. degree since 1996. Presently the department offers a four-semester M.Tech. degree course in Petroleum Exploration and Production and a Ph.D. course. Since the department is uniquely placed in the midst of the age old oil and gas fields of Upper Assam basin, with two major upstream oil public sectors, a hundred year old refinery and an upcoming Gas and Naphtha cracker, the future of the department appears bright and promising.
