The Department of Pharmaceutical Sciences was established towards the end of 1983 to introduce the Four Year integrated Bachelor degree course in Pharmacy (B.Pharm) with the purpose of providing trained technical man power in the field of pharmacy primarily for the North Eastern States of India.

At Present the annual intake in B.Pharm programme is forty(40) of which seven(7) seats are reserved for students of Assam and twelve (12) seats are reserved for other six participating N.E. States with two (2) seats for each State. The remaining 21 seats are under endowment category. The Department of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Dibrugarh University is the first institution in the entire North Eastern region of India to offer B.Pharm degree programme and approved by the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), New Delhi and Pharmacy Council of India (PCI) since its inception.

The Department has pioneered to introduce the post graduate programme in Pharmacy (M. Pharm.) and Ph. D. programme in North Eastern India. The Department offers M.Pharm programme in three specializations viz., Pharmaceutics, Pharmacognosy and Pharmaceutical Chemistry.

DEPARTMENT OF PHYSICS



The Department of Physics, Dibrugarh University was established in the year 1967. The Department has taken up teaching and research programmes in Thin Film, Laser and Spectroscopy, Space and Atmospheric Physics, High Energy Physics and Nano Materials.

The Department has successfully completed a number of major projects funded by UGC-DST, ISRO, etc. More than 70 research scholar have obtained their Doctoral degree from the different fields of this department and settles at various levels in the society. This department has published so far more than 300 research papers in reputed international journals. This department has been funded by DST & UGC, Govt. of India under DST-FIST and SAP-DST programmes.

The Department of Sociology, Dibrugarh University was started in 1967. The introduction of **Sociology** in Post-Graduate level in Dibrugarh University has created a new chapter in the growth and development of Sociology in the North-Eastern Region of India. The course curriculum of the Department at M.A. (CBCS), M.S.W. (Semester) and Ph.D./M.Phil levels has been prepared keeping in view the manpower requirements in various industrial organizations and departments of both public and private sectors. Moreover, this Department has been providing specialized manpower at various capacity to Oil, Coal, Plantation and Power Industries besides various government departments such as State Administrative Services, State Police and Prison Services, State Economic Services, Town Planning, Health and Family Welfare, Social Welfare and Probation etc., besides providing teachers in Sociology for Under Graduate Colleges and Higher Secondary Schools of the region. Of late, under the roof of the Department of Sociology "The Centre for Social Work" has been established from the 2010-11 academic Session for teaching Post Graduate semester course in Master of Social Work (MSW). The Department of Statistics established in 1967 with Dr. S.N.N. Pandit as the founder Professor & Head. Currently the department has nine (8) full time well qualified faculty members. The department has been recognized for its contribution towards the cause of the subject as has so far received financial assistance under DST-FIST (2004-2009). UGC Innovative Programme (2007-2012). SAP-DRS-I of UGC (2009-2014). The main areas of research of the department are Discrete Probability Distribution, Medical Statistics, Statistical Inference, Simulation, Quality Control, Demography, Econometrics and Statistical Ecology. The department has been publishing own peer reviewed research journal " Assam Statistical Review" (ASR) since 1987.

CENTRE FOR ATMOSPHERIC STUDIES



Atmospheric Studies in Physics is the application of physics to the study of the atmosphere. Atmospheric physicists attempt to model Earth's atmosphere and the atmospheres of the other planets using fluid equations, chemical models, radiation balancing, and energy transfer processes in the atmosphere and underlying oceans. It has close links to meteorology and climatology and also covers the design and construction of instruments for studying the atmosphere and the interpretation of the data they provide, including remote sensing instruments. The Centre for Atmospheric Studies (CAS) at Dibrugarh University has been set up with the following two main objectives:

1. To provide a concrete applied research based course of study in the area of atmospheric and environmental sciences, which also aimed at bridging the gap in demand and supply scenario of manpower required in this challenging, specialized as well as highly relevant field of natural science.
2. To promote advanced scientific research in the area of lower and upper atmospheric physics.

CENTRE FOR STUDIES IN BEHAVIOURAL SCIENCES



Dibrugarh University has introduced Applied Psychology at Post Graduate Diploma level in collaboration with the Assam Medical College, Dibrugarh leading to Masters' in Applied Psychology with a permission from the State Government of Assam from the Academic Session 2010-11. The Programme is designed in modular form where the first two semesters (1st and 2nd) shall be considered for the PGDAP and the remaining two (3rd and 4th) Semesters cumulatively with the first two semesters shall be considered for the Masters' in Applied Psychology. There is also the provision of lateral entry in the Masters' level in Applied Psychology Programme for the candidates who have a background in any branch of Psychology at Masters' level or PG Diploma level. In that case, the candidate shall have to take admission in the third semester.

Two batches of students of M.A in Applied Psychology has already passed out since the inception of the Centre. More than 80% of these students have already got absorbed in different fields of Psychology. Students have also been selected for M.Phil in Clinical Psychology at national level which is recognized by Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI) and are also pursuing PH.D at different Central Universities. Many others have already got appointed as clinical psychologists / counsellors in different district Civil Hospitals in Assam as well as K.V. in IIT-G. and other places located in Assam.

CENTRE FOR BIOINFORMATICS STUDIES



Centre for Bioinformatics Studies, is the academic hub for research and education in the field of Bioinformatics, providing M.Sc. Bioinformatics, Ph.D. Bioinformatics course in entire North East India. The centre was established in 17th August, 2007 in Joint academic collaboration with RMRC-ICMR (Indian Council of Medical Research) and NEIST, Jorhat (Formerly RRL, Jorhat). The Centre has good academic relationship with various Research and Educational institutions like Bose Institute, Kolkata, SCF Bio, IIT Delhi, Assam Agricultural University etc. The passed out students has been absorbed in RMRC, NEIST, NERIST, Assam Agricultural University, Rajiv Gandhi University, BCIL and various colleges and Research organizations.

The Centre for Studies in Biotechnology was established in 2005 by Dibrugarh University in collaboration with Regional Medical Research Centre (ICMR), and is supported by the Govt. of Assam and Department of Biotechnology (DBT), Govt. of India to impact quality education in the field of Biotechnology. The Centre has been recognized as Institutional Biotech Hub by DBT, GOL.

In addition, the Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR) and Department of Biotechnology (DBT) conduct all India basis examination to award Junior Research Fellowships (JRFs) to the qualifying candidates to assist them in their Ph. D.

CENTRE FOR COMPUTER STUDIES



The Centre for Computer Studies, Dibrugarh University was established in 1976 (then with the name 'Computer Centre') with a view to support the faculties, staff and other Departments of the University by guiding and giving training on application of computers. Later on, the process of imparting Computer Education was started and since then CCS has been offering diverse courses in the field of Computer Science and Application. In addition, the Centre also provides training and support activities to Government and private institutions. Moreover, the staffs have been involved in social service activities such as imparting computer knowledge based training to financially deprived children of the adjoining rural areas.

CENTRE FOR STUDIES IN GEOGRAPHY



The Centre for Studies in Geography was established in 2008 and a 2 year (Four Semester) M.A./M.Sc. programme in Geography was started. It was a long standing need of the students, researchers and the society at large of the region.

In the present context of Geographical studies, the existing curriculum is not sufficient as far as the regional problems are concerned. The Centre for Studies in Geography, Dibrugarh University reorganised the course in such a way, so that the students get hands-on training through different field oriented programs in GIS and Remote Sensing, Fluvial Geomorphology, Digital Cartography besides the existing subjects like Regional Planning, Political Geography, Population Geography etc. In the Final Semester class the students have to undertake individual projects on different applied aspects of Geography.

Similarly, composite materials is another important discipline known and practiced since prehistoric times. With the advent of modern science and technology, newer composites with tailored properties are being developed. Study of nanoscience and composite materials together will complement each other. The Advanced Diploma Course in Nanoscience and Composite Materials includes topics on formation of nanostructured materials, their electrical and optical properties, magnetic properties, biosynthesis of nanoparticles etc. in composite materials the course include topics on structure and properties of solids, polymer composites, materials characterization, clay chemistry, drilling mud and introduction to corrosion and its control. There will also be practicals relating to nanomaterials and composites and hands on experience in drilling fluid technology. It will be an add on value added course.

CENTRE FOR WOMEN'S STUDIES



Women Studies is an interdisciplinary academic field devoted to topics concerning women, feminism, gender and politics. It often includes feminist theory, socio-cultural history of women, women's fiction, women's health, feminist art, feminist psycho-analysis and gender studies and many other relevant areas. Centre for Women's Studies, Dibrugarh University has been set up with an objective to provide a concrete academic scope for studying multi-dimensional women related issues and to excel higher degree of research, projects as well as to render extension works for reducing gender disparities in the region.

- **Programmes offered:**
 - Post Graduate Certificate Course in Women's Studies (PGCCWS)
 - Ph.D. Programme in Women's Studies including Six-Month Pre-Ph.D. Course work.
- **Eligibility for admission:**
 - PGCCWS : Graduate from any UGC recognized University with minimum 40% marks in aggregate.
 - Ph.D. : Post-Graduates with minimum 50% marks in aggregate in any discipline under Humanities / Social Sciences and qualified in DURAT and /orNET/SET. It shall be followed by an interview to be organized by the centre.
- **Duration:**
 - PGCCWS 1 Year (2 Semester)
- **Intake capacity:**
 - PGCCWS : 15
 - Ph.D. : Depends on the available seats of the concerned supervisors.
- **Programme content:**
 - PGCCWS: The Course will consist of four papers of 100 marks each. 70% will be external evaluation and 30% internal. Internal evaluation will be based on a term paper and oral presentation. Students will have to submit at the end of the course a supervised term paper on the theme selected from the contents of the syllabus.
 - Ph.D. : Each Ph.D. Student shall be required to undertake a six months Ph.D. Course Work on Women's Studies. The Course Work shall be treated as Pre-Ph.D. preparation and includes two papers on Research Methodology and concepts and Issues in Women's Studies.
- **Method of selection:**
 - PGCCWS : On Merit Basis.
 - Ph.D. : Merit Basis and interview.

1. M. Phil.

Master of Philosophy (M.Phil) Programme are available in the subjects : Assamese, Commerce, Chemistry, English, History, Physics, Political Science, Sociology, Statistics, Mathematics, Economics and Education.

Eligibility for admission :

Candidates must have passed M.A./M.Sc./M.Com/M.Tech. Examination of Dibrugarh University or any other University recognised as equivalent by this University securing a minimum of 50% marks in the subject in which he/she intends to pursue the course, and must clear DURAT conducted by Dibrugarh University.

Under special circumstances a candidate may be allowed by the Research Council on recommendation of the Departmental Research Committee to pursue the course in a subject other than one in which he/she has obtained Master degree, provided that the Research Council is satisfied that the branches are interrelated and the candidate is competent to undertake the course in that particular subject.

Admission Procedure :

The candidates shall apply for admission in the prescribed form in response to the notification inviting such applications directly to the concerned Department after clearing the Dibrugarh University Research Admission Test (DURAT).

Duration : One year.

Attendance :

(A) All M.Phil students shall be required to :

- (i) attend a minimum of 75% of the total Lectures prescribed and delivered for the course.
 - (ii) attend and participate in atleast three seminars to be organised by the Department,
 - (iii) write atleast one seminar paper pertaining to his/her dissertation and present it for discussion.
- (B) Irregular attendance and/or unsatisfactory performance at the seminars/tutorials shall disqualify an M.Phil student from further continuation of the course if so decided by the Research Committee.

2. Ph. D.

The Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D) programme covers the following areas : Humanities, Social Sciences, Law, Commerce, Science, Technology, Computer Sciences, Engineering, Medical Sciences including Homeopathy and Pharmaceutical Sciences, and Business Administration.

Eligibility for admission :

- (i) A candidate (other than candidates from Medical and Engineering streams) seeking admission to the course for the degree of Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) shall have to obtain at least 50% marks in Master's Degree OR equivalent grade point.

All applicants seeking admission to the doctoral programme of the University [except foreign students applying for admission as provided for under clause 9] must clear the Dibrugarh University
