

Research Admission Test (DURAT) Candidates with M.Phil degree (regular mode) are exempted from appearing in the DURAT.

- (ii) A candidate may also be enrolled if he / she has any other degree recognised as equivalent to the Master's Degree in the subject in which the candidate wishes to pursue a course of reserch, provided the candidate fulfills the conditions at (i) above.
- (iii) Under special circumstances, a candidate may be allowed by the Research Council to undertake research in a subject other than one in which he/ she has obtained Master's Degree. Before permitting the candidate to do so, the Council shall satisfy itself that the branches are inter-related and /or the candidate is competent to undertake research in the particular subject as evidenced by published/practical works.
- (iv) For doing Ph.D. in Engineering / Technology/Medical Science, a candidate must have a Masters' Degree in Engineering / Technology/Medical Science with a minimum of 55% marks.
- (v) A candidate with a B.E./B.Tech Degree with a valid JRF-GATE score may also be considered for admission to the Ph.D. programme.

Admission Procedure:

- (i) The candidate shall apply for admission to the Chairperson, Departmental Research Committee of the Department in which he/ she desires to pursue research.
- (ii) The application for admission must be made in the prescribed form obtainable from the Office of the Dy. Registrar, (Academic) on payment of prescribed fees and will be received throughout the year. The application must be submitted through a recognised Ph.D. Supervisor and should be accompanied by an outline of statement in triplicate on the subject of the proposed investigation.

3. D.Litt/D.Sc.

The degree of D.Litt/D.Sc. of Dibrugarh University is awarded to a candidate adjudged to have distinguished himself/ herself as an authority in the field of his/ her study on the basis of a thesis or a published research work, illustrating substantial and original contributions towards advancement of learning.

Eligibility :

Any Scholar having a Ph.D. degree of Dibrugarh University or an equivalent Degree of any other University duly recognised by Dibrugarh University may apply for registration to the degree of D.Litt/D.Sc not before three years after obtaining Ph.D.

Admission Procedure :

A candidate for the degree of D.Litt./ D.Sc. shall apply on prescribed form obtainable from the Office of the Deputy Registrar, (Academic) on payment of a prescribed fee.

The application for registration must be accompanied by -

- (i) Four copies of outline of the proposed work;
- (ii) A signed statement giving the particulars relating to his/her contributions towards the advancement of knowledge on the subject; and
- (iii) Evidence of substantial research work during the intervening period (i.e. the period between getting Ph.D. and submission of application for registration) supported by documents.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

How to obtain forms :

Applications for admission to M.A., M.Sc., M.Com, M. Pharm and M.Tech. courses are invited usually in the month of June.

Candidates are to apply in prescribed form only. Form alongwith the Information Brochure can be obtained from the **Office of the Deputy Registrar, (Academic)** on payment of **Rs 300/-** in cash or bank draft drawn on State Bank of India, Dibrugarh University Branch in favour of **Registrar, Dibrugarh University**. Forms can also be obtained by post by sending a bank draft of **Rs.300/-** alongwith a self addressed stamped enveloped of 25 x 30 c.m. size to the Deputy Registrar, (Academic), Dibrugarh University. The University Authorities shall, however, not be responsible for non-delivery/late delivery of forms sent by post. Forms downloaded from the website : **dibru.ac.in** shall also be accepted provided it is submitted along with a bank draft of **Rs. 300/-** as mentioned above.

Submission of Forms :

Completed forms accompanied by attested copies of all testimonials are to be submitted to the respective Heads of Departments / Centre of Studies . No application shall be received after the last date fixed for the purpose.

Note : Except S.C., S.T. and OBC all other candidates desiring consideration under the other reserved categories should submit their applications to the Office of the Deputy Registrar, (Academic).

Selection Procedure :

Different Selection procedures are adopted

for admission to the various academic programmes of Dibrugarh University, such as : (a) selection on merit basis, (b) through Entrance Test organised centrally or departmentally or / and (c) through Personal Interview decided by the University from time to time.

The list of the selected candidates shall be put up on the Notice Boards of the Departments/ Centres concerned and they would not be intimated individually. Candidates may be called for interview on the date and venue to be decided by the concerned Heads of the Departments/ Centre of Studies.

Finally, selected candidates shall have to get themselves admitted on the same day of interview or as specified by the Departments/ Centre of Studies on payment of the prescribed fee.

Waiting List :

Each Department /Centre shall prepare a waiting list of candidates if necessary. Candidates in the waiting list may also be called for interview along with the provisionally selected candidates. Vacant seats, if any, shall be filled up from the candidates in the waiting list. No student from the waiting list shall, however, be admitted to any Department/ Centre of Studies after 30 days from the commencement of class in a Semester/ Session.

Cancellation of seats :

- (i) A candidate shall forfeit his/her seat if admission is not taken on the specific date.
- (ii) A student shall also forfeit the seat if he/



she fails to attend classes without valid ground and permission of the Head of the Department/Centre of Studies concerned for fifteen consecutive days from the date of commencement of class.

- (iii) The name of a student shall also be struck off the rolls of all the Departments of the University if he/she is admitted to more than one course of study in the University Departments or in any other University/ Institution during the academic session in which he/she is admitted to the University classes.

Admission to next higher class :

All students of the M.A., M.Sc., M.Com., M.Tech., M.Pharm courses on completion of a semester shall be admitted to the next higher class on payment of sessional dues within the prescribed period. They must produce the official receipt of the payment of sessional dues to the respective Head of Departments/Centre of Studies for record

and to get their names registered in the Department/Centre of Studies. The semester admission fee must be paid at the time of admission.

Admission to Hostels :

Hostel seats are limited. All students admitted to the various courses cannot be provided with hostel accommodation. Hostel seat is provided strictly on merit basis depending on availability of seats. Reservation of seats for S.C. and S.T. candidates is made as per rules of the University.

Attendance :

A student shall attend a minimum of 85% of the total number of classes held. If the percentage of attendance does not fall below 75% a student may be permitted to appear as a 'non-collegiate' student on payment of prescribed fine. However, regulations on attendance may be prescribed separately by various departments/Centre of Studies.

Note : Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited in Dibrugarh University. If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, the same shall be dealt with as per Rules. Students found involved in ragging may be expelled or handed over to the police if found necessary.

RESERVATION AND RELAXATION FOR ADMISSION

RESERVATION OF SEATS:

1. For Graduates of Dibrugarh University:

80% of the total seats in each subject under M.A./M.Sc./M.Com. programmes are reserved for the graduates of Dibrugarh University.

The remaining 20% seats are open for admission on merit basis only to the graduates of all recognized Universities other than Dibrugarh University.

2. Reservation of seats on other ground:

(i) Statutory Reservation:

Scheduled Caste (S.C.) -7%

Scheduled Tribes, Plains (S.T.P.)-10%

Scheduled Tribes, Hills (S.T.H.)-5%

Other Backward Classes (O.B.C. / M.O.B.C.)-15%

Note: Caste Certificates must be issued by the competent authorities and countersigned by the Deputy Commissioner of the District concerned. Except statutory reservations, other kinds of reservations are not applicable for research programmes, viz. Ph.D. and M.Phil. programmes.

(ii) Differently-abled:

3% of the total seats in each Department and Centres of Studies are reserved for the differently-abled students. Candidates applying for consideration under this category must submit Medical Certificate issued by the Joint Director of Health Services of the district concerned and countersigned on verification by the Senior Medical Officer, Dibrugarh University. Those who on the pretext of being

very negligibly differently-abled by visual deficiency and the like shall not be eligible for consideration under this reserved category.

(iii) Sons and Daughters of Dibrugarh University Employees:

A total of not more than six seats are reserved for sons and daughters of the employees of Dibrugarh University in the academic programmes, viz. **M.A./M.Sc. in Anthropology, Applied Geology, Assamese, Chemistry, Economics, Education, English, History, Life Sciences, Mathematics, Physics, Political Science, Sociology, Statistics and M.Com.**

For all other academic programmes (excluding Diploma and Certificate programmes), five (5) marks shall be added to the total marks secured by the sons and daughters of Dibrugarh University employees in the Qualifying Examination/Entrance Examination. **However, this criterion shall not be applicable in the selection procedure in which candidates are selected on the basis of CAT/MAT/CMAT/GATE/GPAT score.**

(iv) Extra Curricular Activities:

(A) Sports: A total of **seven seats** for all the Departments taken together.

Eligibility - Must have represented Dibrugarh University/State (Assam) in any of the Olympic disciplines or Cricket conducted by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU), New Delhi/ National Sports Federation as recognized by the Sports Authority of India (SAI)/Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India.

Participation in the above-mentioned games and sports must not be earlier than three years before the academic session in which admission is sought.



The candidates may have to appear in a Qualifying Test in the concerned discipline.

(B) Art/Culture: A total of **two seats**.

Eligibility - Proficiency in Fine Arts or performing Arts, as evidenced by participation at the recognized Regional/National level competitions representing Dibrugarh University/State (Assam).

The candidates may have to appear in a Qualifying Test in the concerned discipline.

(C) Literary: A total of two seats **(Restricted to the M.A. Programmes in English and Assamese)**

Eligibility - Certificate of winning award/prizes in literary competitions of Inter University/National level **Or** having standard published work. (Selection will be made by a committee to be constituted by the Vice-Chancellor).

(D) N.C.C.: Three seats.

Eligibility - Representation of the State (of Assam) in the Republic Day Parade in New Delhi sponsored by the Regional Directorate, N.C.C. or having N.C.C. 'C' certificate.

(E) N.S.S.: Three seats.

Eligibility - Representation of Dibrugarh University in Republic Day parade at New Delhi, participation in at least one national level N.S.S. camp and other programmes under Dibrugarh University.

(v) Tea and Ex-tea Community:

A total of five seats (two each in Arts and Science and one in Commerce).

(Interchangeable if necessary)

Eligibility - Must be permanent resident of Assam.

(vi) Local Gaon Panchayats:

Five seats (two each in Arts & Science and one in Commerce).

(Interchangeable if necessary)

Eligibility - Applicants must be sons/daughters of the residents of the villages that falls under the **Local Gaon Panchayats** as mentioned below.

Local Gaon Panchayats selected:

- Rajabheta Gaon Panchayat.
- Borpathar Gaon Panchayat.
- Chiring Dainijan Gaon Panchayat.

The applicants and either of their parents must reside for a period of not less than ten years immediately preceding the academic year for which admission is sought.

The applicants must submit a certificate of residence from the President of the concerned Gaon Panchayat and countersigned by the B.D.O of the concerned Development Block. The format of the certificate shall be available in the website of Dibrugarh University. (The Secretary of the Gaon Panchayat shall issue such certificates in absence of the President). The candidates shall also have to submit an affidavit on a stamped paper declaring that they are the residents of the concerned villages.

(vii) One seat each in the M.A., M.Sc. and M.Com. courses on supernumerary basis for the widows/wards of armed forces personnel killed/disabled in action or during peace time as per priority: I) Widows/wards of Defence personal killed in action; II) Wards of serving personnel and ex-servicemen disabled in action; III) Widows/wards of Defence personnel who died in peace-time with death attributable to military service; IV) Wards of Defence personnel disabled in peace-time with disability attributable to military service.

(viii) Three seats for the applicants of the Moran Community and two seats for the applicants of the Matak Community to be adjusted against 15% reserved seats for OBC candidates in the departments concerned.

RESERVATION AND RELAXATION FOR ADMISSION

- (ix) 5% seats are earmarked for children of Indian workers in the Gulf out of the 15% supernumerary seats for admission to foreign students in the university.
 - (x) Two seats on supernumerary basis are reserved in all the teaching Departments and Centres of Studies for the candidates belonging to Jammu and Kashmir.
- c. In an academic programme, not more than one seat from a category [except statutory reservations and the applicants under Clause 2(iii)] shall be admissible.
 - d. Not more than 7% of the total unreserved seats shall be allotted to any department **provided that this condition shall not include the applicants under Clause 2(iii).**

Note:

- a. All the candidates mentioned under Clause 2 are entitled to a relaxation of 5% marks in eligibility for admission.
 - b. The number of seats reserved under Clause 2 (i) and (ii) is meant for each academic programme. The number of seats reserved under Clause 2 (iv-A-E), (v) and (vi) pertains to the academic programmes taken together **viz. M.A./M.Sc. in Anthropology, Applied Geology, Assamese, Chemistry, Economics, Education, English, History, Life Sciences, Mathematics, Physics, Political Science, Sociology, Statistics and M.Com.**
- e. Candidates seeking admission under reserved seats must be permanent residents of Assam.
 - f. Candidates seeking admission under Clause 2 (ii), (iii), (iv), (v), (vi), (vii) and (viii) shall have to **fill an additional prescribed form which shall be available in the website of Dibrugarh University.**
 - g. **Candidates seeking admission under general / statutory reservation category in the Departments and Centres of Studies are requested to submit application form to the Departments/Centres concerned.**



ADMISSION RULES FOR FOREIGN/NRI STUDENTS

1.0 General:

The Dibrugarh University agrees in principle to admit Foreign/NRI students to the Post-Graduate, Undergraduate and Diploma programmes in different fields to provide educational opportunities to Foreign/NRI students.

2.0 Reservation of seats:

2.1 15% seats on supernumerary basis are reserved for admission in the various academic programmes in the University Departments/Centres of Studies for the foreign/NRI students.

2.2 5% seats are earmarked for children of Indian workers in the Gulf out of the 15% supernumerary seats as mentioned in 2.1.

3.0 Category of Foreign/NRI students:

Foreign/NRI students are categorized as follows:

- i. Students from the SAARC countries.
- ii. Students from the non-SAARC countries.

4.0 Eligibility:

4.1 Qualification:

The qualifications required for eligibility for admission to different programmes can be checked in detail from the Information Brochure or University website. The minimum educational qualification for admission of Foreign/NRI students in various programmes is same as for Indians.

Only those students who have qualified from Foreign Universities or Boards of Higher Education, recognized as equivalent by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) are eligible for admission. When required, a reference will be made to AIU to check the equivalence.

5.0 Visa Requirements:

On being granted admission, all applicants should produce their Students Visa at the time of admission.

6.0 Medical test:

All Foreign/NRI students will have to undergo a medical fitness test including HIV test before taking final admission.

7.0 Medical Insurance

It is advised that all Foreign/NRI students take a medical insurance policy to meet the expenses of medical treatments (which are not available in the university health centre) during the stay at the university. A copy of the said insurance policy should be submitted at the time of final admission.

8.0 Proficiency in English

The Foreign/NRI students who have been provisionally admitted should be proficient in English and they need to submit a certificate to this effect in order to certify the following:

- i) The student has passed the qualifying examination in English medium.

OR

- ii) The student has a valid score in Proficiency Test in English like TOFEL and ELTIS.

9.0 Admission

9.1 Admission information:

Students willing to join the University for various programmes will get the information about the application form and the information on the eligibility requirements, programmes available and admission procedure from the information brochure or the website of the University.

9.2 Admission procedure:

9.2.1 Apply for admissions into the academic programmes in the prescribed form which can be downloaded from the University website.

9.2.2 Attach with this application form photostat copies of the statement of marks/Transcript and all other relevant documents duly attested by:

- a. Indian Embassy in foreign country, or
- b. High Commissioner of students' country in India, or
- c. Ministry of Education in foreign country.

9.2.3 Attach Migration Certificate in original with the application form. This is obligatory for those coming from any other Statutory Indian University.

10.0 Scholarship

University does not have any provision for scholarships for foreign students. The University shall receive scholarships if sanctioned and released by the sponsoring authority and shall disburse to the awardees as per the terms and conditions of the university i.e. regularity in attendance, progress, good character and conduct.

11.0 Other Information

11.1 Certificates & documents required along with the application form

- (i) Proof of Date of Birth.
- (ii) Translated copies of all Mark sheets/ Transcript/Certificates (front & back).

(iii) Conduct and Character Certificate from the institution last attended.

(iv) Copies of passport and visa.

11.2 Non-Resident Indian (NRI)

An applicant shall be considered an NRI on satisfying the following condition:

The term "Non-Resident Indian" shall be as per the Income Tax Law. However, notwithstanding any amendment in such laws, all rights, obligations and duties flowing and subsisting at the time of submission of application shall be respected and mandated till finalization of the programme applied for.

The following documents are required along with the application form for NRI applicants:

- (i) Copy of passport of parent working abroad.
- (ii) Copy of work permit/license to work/business.
- (iii) Copy of residence permit/visa.
- (iv) Letter from the employer.
- (v) Affidavit from the parent for financial support.
- (vi) NRI Status certificate issued by the Indian Embassy in the concerned country.

12.0 On all other matters not covered under the aforesaid rules, decisions of the competent authorities shall be binding on the part of Foreign/NRI students.

Notwithstanding anything contained in the above clauses, the decision of the Government of India on admission of Foreign/NRI students shall be made applicable.



REGULATIONS FOR PROHIBITING RAGGING AND ANTI-RAGGING MEASURES

A Regulation to provide measures for prohibiting, preventing and eliminating the scourge of ragging in Dibrugarh University including any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student, or indulging in rowdy or indisciplined activities by any student or students which cause or are likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student or asking any student to do any act, which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student, with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student, in Dibrugarh University and thereby, to provide for the healthy development, physically and psychologically, of all students of the University.

1. TITLE, COMMENCEMENT AND APPLICABILITY

- 1.1. This Regulation may be called Dibrugarh University Regulations for Prohibiting Ragging and Anti-Ragging Measures.
- 1.2. They shall come into force from the academic session 2013–14.
- 1.3. This Regulation shall encompass all the students of the University and the Dibrugarh University shall mean and include all its Departments, Centres of Studies, all the premises whether being academic, residential, playgrounds, hostels, canteens or such other premises

whether located within the campus or outside, and to all means of transportation of students, whether public or private, accessed by students for the pursuit of studies.

2. OBJECTIVES

To prohibit any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student, or indulging in rowdy or indiscipline activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student or asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student, with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student; and thereby, to eliminate ragging in all its forms from Dibrugarh University by prohibiting it under these Regulations, preventing its occurrence and punishing those who indulge in ragging as provided for in these Regulations and the appropriate law in force.

3. WHAT CONSTITUTES RAGGING

One or more of any of the following acts constitute(s) Ragging

- a. any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student;

- b. indulging in rowdy or indisciplined activities by any student or students which cause or are likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student;
- c. asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student;
- d. any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher;
- e. exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students.
- f. any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students;
- g. any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person;
- h. any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, post, public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student ;
- i. any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student.

4. MEASURES FOR PROHIBITION OF RAGGING

The Dibrugarh University shall not permit or condone any reported incident of ragging in any form and the University shall take all necessary

and required measures to achieve the objective of eliminating ragging within or outside the University relating to any student of the University. The University shall take strict action against those found guilty of ragging and / or abetting ragging, actively or passively, or being part of a conspiracy to promote ragging.

5. MEASURES FOR PREVENTION OF RAGGING

The Dibrugarh University, by following the UGC Regulation, shall undertake to take the following steps.

5.1 FORMATION OF ANTI-RAGGING COMMITTEE (ARC)

The University has an Anti-Ragging Committee with members from outside and inside the University community under the Chairmanship of the Vice-Chancellor to oversee overall Anti-Ragging initiatives.

5.2 ANTI-RAGGING SQUAD (ARS)

The University also has a smaller body known as the Anti-Ragging Squad for maintaining vigil, surprise inspection, oversight and patrolling. The ARS is mobile, alert and active at all times.

The ARS formed as per the notification No. DU/SWS/ARC-ARS/98/2011/696, dated 28.07.2011 is on page 1.

5.2.1 DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF ANTI-RAGGING SQUAD (ARS)

- a. To maintain round the clock strict vigilance on the University campus particularly during the odd hours at the University hostels.
- b. To undertake patrolling and make surprise visits to places vulnerable to incidents of ragging.
- c. To conduct on the spot of enquiry into any incident of ragging referred to it by the Head of the Institution or any member of the faculty or any member of the staff or any student or any parent or guardian or any employee of a service



provider or by any other person as the case may be and the enquiry report along with the recommendations shall be submitted to the Anti Ragging Committee for action under clause 7 of the Regulation.

Provided that the Anti-Ragging Squad shall conduct such enquiry observing a fair and transparent procedure and the principle of natural justice and after giving adequate opportunity to the student or students accused of ragging and other witnesses to place before it the facts, documents and views concerning the incident of ragging, and considering such other relevant information as may be required.

6. ACTION TO BE TAKEN BY THE UNIVERSITY

On receipt of the recommendation of the Anti-Ragging Squad or on receipt of any information concerning any reported incident of ragging, the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor shall immediately determine if a case under the penal laws is made out and if so, either on his own or through a member of the Anti-Ragging Committee authorised by him in this behalf, proceed to file a First Information Report (FIR), within twenty four hours of receipt of such information or recommendation, with the police and local authorities, under the appropriate penal provisions relating to one or more of the following.

- i. Abetment to ragging
- ii. Criminal conspiracy to rag
- iii. Unlawful assembly and rioting while ragging
- iv. Public nuisance created during ragging
- v. Violation of decency and morals through ragging
- vi. Injury to body, causing hurt or grievous hurt
- vii. Wrongful restraint
- viii. Wrongful confinement

- ix. Use of criminal force
- x. Assault as well as sexual offences or unnatural offences
- xi. Extortion
- xii. Criminal trespass
- xiii. Offences against property
- xiv. Criminal intimidation
- xv. Attempts to commit any or all of the above mentioned offences against the victim(s)
- xvi. Threat to commit any or all of the above mentioned offences against the victim(s)
- xvii. Physical or psychological humiliation
- xviii. All other offences following from the definition of "Ragging"

Provided that the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor shall forthwith report the occurrence of the incident of ragging to the District Level Anti-Ragging Committee.

Provided further that the institution shall also continue with its own enquiry initiated under clause 7 of these Regulations and other measures without waiting for action on the part of the police / local authorities and such remedial action shall be initiated and completed immediately and in no case later than a period of 10 (ten) days of the reported occurrence of the incident of ragging.

7. ADMINISTRATIVE ACTION IN THE EVENT OF RAGGING

The University shall issue an order to punish a student found guilty of ragging after following the procedure and in the manner prescribed hereinunder

- a) The Anti-Ragging Committee of the institution shall take appropriate decision, in regard to punishment or otherwise, depending on the facts of each incident of ragging and nature and gravity of the incident of ragging

established in the recommendations of the Anti-Ragging Squad.

- b)** The Anti-Ragging Committee may, depending on the nature and gravity of the guilt established by the Anti-Ragging Squad, award, to those found guilty, one or more of the following punishments.
- i.** Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
 - ii.** Withholding / withdrawing scholarship / fellowship and other benefits.
 - iii.** Debarring from appearing in any test / examination or other evaluation process.
 - iv.** Withholding results.
 - v.** Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
 - vi.** Suspension / expulsion from the hostel.
 - vii.** Cancellation of admission.
 - viii.** Rustication from the institution for period ranging from one to four semesters.
 - ix.** Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period.
 - x.** Fine of ' 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) only or with imprisonment upto 06 months as per the Assam Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1999.
 - xi.** To undertake patrolling and make surprise visits to places vulnerable to incidents of ragging.

Provided that where the persons committing or abetting the act of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment.

- c)** An appeal against the order of punishment as recommended by the Anti-Ragging

Committee shall lie on the Executive Council of the Dibrugarh University.

8. RIGHTS AND DUTIES OF THE FRESHERS AND THEIR GUARDIANS

The fresher shall after their admission should consider the University as their second home behaving in the most humble manner and maintain cordial relationship with the senior students, fellow students, faculty and staffs of the University. The Dibrugarh University shall always strive to establish ragging free environment and in case the freshers feel that they are subjected to any form of ragging elaborated hereinabove, they should immediately report the matter to any member of the Anti-Ragging Committee, Anti-Ragging Squad, faculty, staff or to the Registrar of the University. The guardian shall co-operate with the authority to redress the grievance and help prevent the occurrence of ragging in the University. The identity of the fresher / guardian shall be protected and shall not be divulged.

9. RIGHTS AND DUTIES OF THE SENIOR STUDENTS

The senior students have a special responsibility of welcoming the freshers to the University for upkeeping the image of the University and the educational status of the region. Being the higher institution of learning, the senior students are expected to lead by example which paves the way for a very healthy and the right atmosphere in pursuit of higher learning in Dibrugarh University. The senior students has to bear the added responsibility to report an incident of ragging in the University immediately on coming to know about such incident in the capacity of a complainant or witness whose identity shall be kept confidential.

10. MODIFICATION OF THE REGULATION

If any difficulty arises in giving effect to any provisions of this Regulation, the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor with consultation with the members of the ARC shall modify any clause of the Regulation, subject to notification by the appropriate statutory body of the University.



11. FRESHERS INTRODUCTION / INDUCTION

A systematically organized Freshers' Introductions / Ice-Breaking sessions will be organized by various Departments as per policy issued by the University which would conform with the decorum and dignity as expected by the University and act as a forerunner for introductions and ice breaking between seniors and freshers.

12. AFFIDAVIT BY THE STUDENT AND GUARDIAN:

- 12.1. All students and parents / guardian of the Dibrugarh University taking fresh admission in the academic session 2014-15 are to submit 02 (two) copies of duly notarized affidavit signed by the student and his / her parent / guardian to the Head or Director of the Department or Centres of Study respectively, as the case may be, stating that they have gone through this booklet and the UGC Regulations on curbing the menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institution, 2009 and understood the definitions of

ragging and implications of being involved in ragging; that they had never been involved in any act of ragging anywhere; and that they will fight for a Ragging Free University. The format of affidavits are enclosed herein as Annexure-I and Annexure-II.

- 12.2. The Head of Department / Directors of the Centres of Study shall forward the affidavits collected from all the students of academic session 2014-15 in a single lot with a list of the name of admitted students to the Registrar immediately after the process of admission is over.
- 12.3. The Public Information-cum-Law Officer, Dibrugarh University shall be the custodian of all the executed affidavit and the students may contact the Public Information-cum-Law Officer, Dibrugarh University in his Mob. No. 94011 08009 regarding any clarification for execution of the affidavits.
